# PROPOSED HIGHWAY CLOSURE BEACONSFIELD ROAD LEADING TO NEW CHESTER ROAD, NEW FERRY (BROMBOROUGH WARD) SECTION 257 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

#### 1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1.1 To request Members' approval to commence the legal proceedings for the permanent closure of a section of adopted footpath leading from Beaconsfield Road to New Chester Road, New Ferry.

#### 2.0 REPORT

- 2.1 The Director of Property Services in conjunction with the developer, has requested that the area of adopted footpath highlighted on the plan, be officially closed.
- 2.2 The closure will facilitate the redevelopment of the site and the demolition of the disused petrol station which currently occupies the site.

#### 3.0 FINANCIAL AND STAFFING IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The closure will be carried out by existing staff as part of their normal duties. All legal and administration costs will be met by the developer. The closure of areas of adopted footpath reduces the Authority's potential maintenance liability.

#### 5.0 PLANNING IMPLICATIONS

5.1 Planning permission is to be sought for the redevelopment of the site for housing purposes.
