Dear Sir,


I am writing to register an objection to the granting of a License to sell alcohol at the proposed Tesco Express Store in Claughton Village from 07.00-22.00 seven days a week. I understand that at the Planning Committee Meeting on 31<sup>st</sup> July, opening hours were approved for trading 7.00-22.00 six days a week and 09.00-22.00 on a Sunday, so there would appear to be a discrepancy between this application for longer sales hours than are presently permitted. I am sure you will clarify this issue in considering the application.

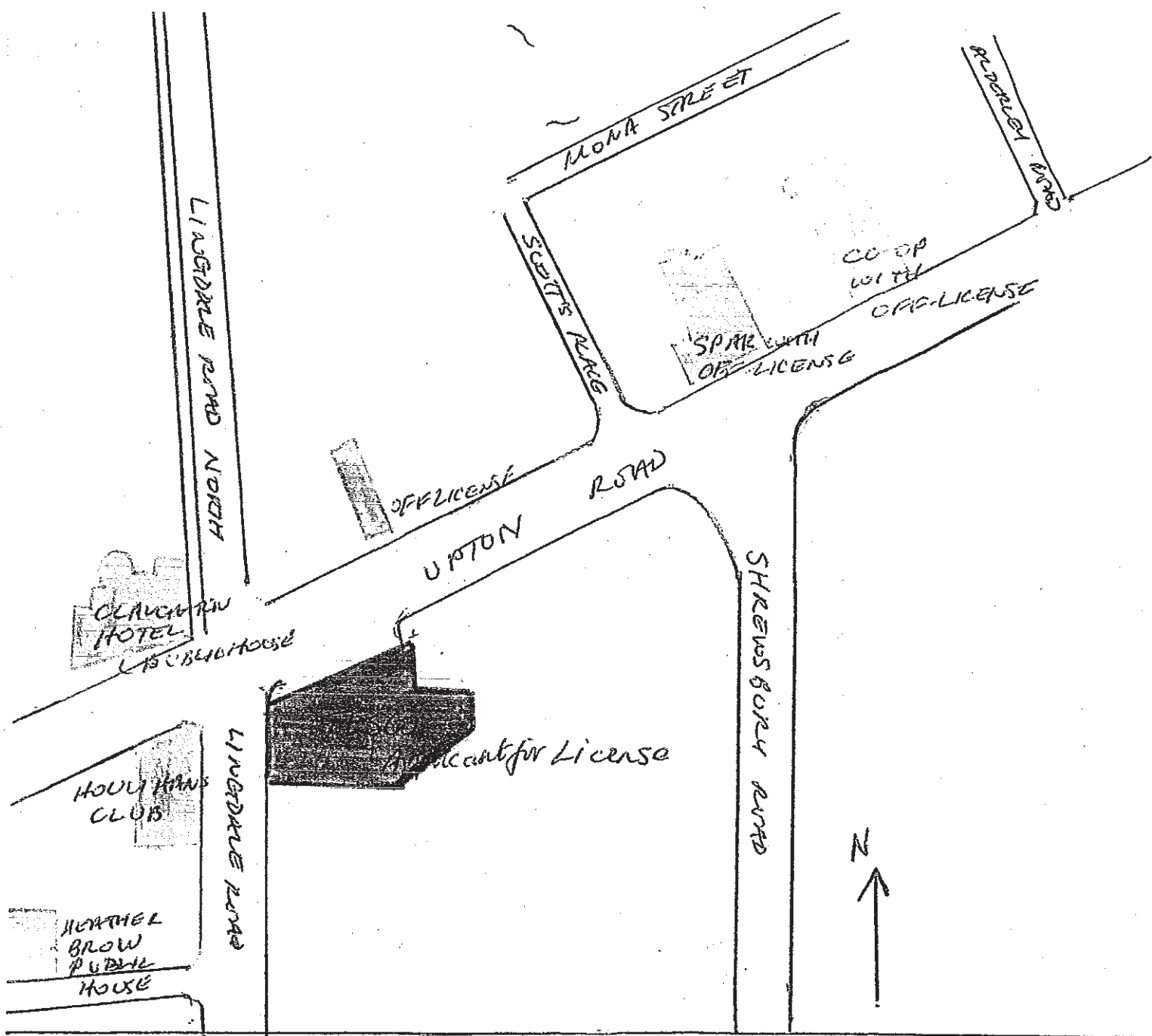
I enclose a sketch to show the number of licensed premises already within the immediate vicinity of the store – two Public Houses, one Club and one Off-License – and two further convenience stores, the Spar and the Coop, scarcely a minute's walk away

Considerable concern has already been expressed recently in newspapers, the media and by doctors about the high level of alcohol abuse, alcohol-related illnesses and violence and underage age drinking on the Wirral. Claughton Village, its side roads and the environs of nearby Birkenhead Park give daily testimony of these activities with broken bottles of alcohol and beer cans on pavements and in hedges and evidence of vomit and regular urination in gateways and entrances.

Whilst realizing Tesco's desire to sell alcohol, this is not one supported by most local, mature residents, who already have ample access to the purchase of alcohol in Claughton Village and are fully aware that they can obtain alcohol from a 24 hour Tesco Extra less than 2 miles away. The granting of this application can only be an encouragement to furthering the problems of alcohol abuse in the area. It would behove the Committee to remember that Bourneville in Birmingham had the courage to deny Tesco a license there, and I ask you to show the same courage to deny this application, being aware of the social implications of granting a license which will bring seven outlets for alcohol within two minutes walk of each other.

**P** Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

**a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)**

We are a national retailer that sells alcohol as part of a broad offering of goods and services. We have held off-licences in our stores for many years and are an approved British Institute of Inn-keeping examination centre. We have written training policies and formal training programmes are in place, which ensure our people are equipped to meet all licensing objectives. All training and revision/refresher materials are reviewed regularly. We have introduced our 'Think 21' policy to all of our stores in July 2004, this policy is brought to customer's attention through point of sale material at the checkout and wherever alcohol is displayed for sale. We take legal compliance very seriously and in addition to local training we employ a central alcohol licensing compliance manager and have a compliance committee.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

The premises will have digital CCTV system that covers many areas of the shop floor, including the proposed area which will be used for beer and wine, should we be successful with our application. Images will be retained for a minimum of 21 days and made available on enforcement request. A member of the Management team will be on the premises all the time the store is open. Checkout area will be constantly manned whilst the store is open.

**c) Public safety**

A member of the Management team will be on the premises all the time the store is open and will be trained to manage the store including looking after the safety of the public. The store will adhere to all rules and regulations relating to public safety.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

The store intends to be an active member of the community. We will be happy to liaise with Police and enforcement authorities should the need arise.

**e) The protection of children from harm**


All staff will be trained and regularly refreshed in the corporate 'Think 21' Policy. Staff will be trained to look at the customer and 'Think 21' when selling age restricted products. A till prompt will appear on the initial sale of alcohol that will remind the seller of the Think 21 policy and remind staff not to sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 18. When alcohol is refused by the seller after the product has been scanned the refusal will be recorded in a report that can be produced at store level on a weekly basis. The store will display signage around the premises informing both staff and customers of our 'Think 21' policy.
