 - Exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the Licence.
 - Remove the Designated Premises Supervisor.
 - Suspend the Licence for a period not exceeding three months.
 - Revoke the Licence.

The licensing authority may decide that no action is appropriate if it finds that the Review does not require it to take any steps that are appropriate to promote the licensing objectives.

3.3 APPLICATION

- 3.4 An application has been received from the Licensing Authority to review the Premises Licence for the premises known as The Venue. The grounds for review are in relation to evidence of drug taking at the premises, breaches of the Premises Licence conditions and the fire exits being blocked.
