Dear Licensing,

Please can you address this letter as confidential and with hold my name and any information which would lead others to identify the sender.

I would like to take this opportunity to ask the council to object to the proposed extension in the opening of the seating area at the front of the Pensby Hotel. I would also like the Council to take this opportunity to insist that the Pub address the existing regulations and maintain these.

The present situation was last looked at by the Council back in Feb 2006 and allowed people to sit outside the Pub till 21:00hrs and consume alcohol. The Council at that time felt that was a fair and proper time, and was just to both the Pub and the local residence. I believe that this remains an appropriate time and that there is no reason why this status quo needs to be changed.

The idea of allowing people to sit outside to drink whilst they have a cigarette will only lead to more noise and disruption to the local area. The present situation has seen people drinking outside after 22:30hrs and the language from some of the patrons becoming louder with some of the content being vulgar.

If this is passed or even increased slightly then how would the Council and the Police protect the local residence from the noise and the verbal obscenities that occur outside the pub?

How will you be able to stop the downward spiral in house prices?

With regards the extension to the licensing hours, I believe that the pub should show a lengthier period of settled behaviour before such a request is considered.

Please can I request that you maintain the status quo and oppose the request to change the License.

Noise complaints from nearby residents about this hotel have been in two distinct categories:

1) Noise from music in the Function Room emitted through opened windows. Complainants have said that whenever they telephone the Licensee to complain, the windows are then closed; but, allegedly, this problem keeps recurring.

and

2) Noise from customers congregating in the outside areas. I have received complaints that management begin to clear the outside areas of customers at the current time of 9pm, rather than completing the task by that time. Allegedly, it is sometimes almost 10pm by the time that customers leave this area.

The problem of late-night smokers using the outside area, is also exacerbated by customers being allowed to take their drinks out with them when they go out to smoke.

If the Panel has a mind to grant this application, I would recommend the following conditions to try to counter the above noise problems (some of which are in the current licence & some are new):

- 1) There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.

2) Bottles or broken glasses shall not be disposed of from the premises between the hours of 9.00pm and 9.00am so as not to cause a disturbance to residents in the vicinity of the premises.

3) There should be diligent control over the levels of any music played to ensure compliance with the following condition:

"No nuisance shall be caused by noise coming from the premises or by vibration noise transmitted through the structure of the Premises".

Also, as part of that control, whenever music playing:

a) All windows & doors (apart from access & egress) to be closed.

and

b) Noise emissions to be periodically checked outside & results logged.

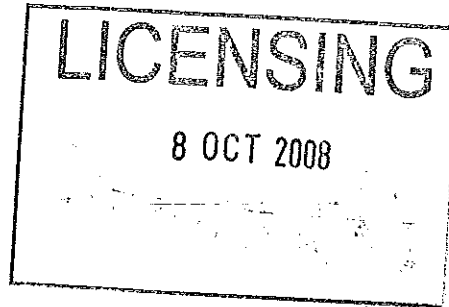
However, with regard to the above condition about windows being closed whenever music is playing, I would suggest that the Panel should invite the applicant to explain how they intend to improve their compliance with this condition (e.g. locking the windows to the function room).

4) Whatever time the panel decide to clear the outside area of customers, other than for smokers, the condition should clearly specify that no drinks or food to be taken outside after that time. Also I suggest that it be made clear to the applicant that clearing the outside area of customers eating/drinking by a specified time should begin well before that time to ensure proper compliance.

To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to you with regards to my recent licence variation application. After some thought and a few conversations with local responsible authorities I would like to drop a small part of my application. I believe that it would be best for all parties concerned to remove the request to open the new enclosed area after 10pm.

There was also a representation made by the environmental health with several suggested conditions, and a number of possible improvements. I have taken this on board and believe that what has been asked for and/ or suggested is more than reasonable and am happy for those to be made a condition of the variation.

The environmental health raised the following points;

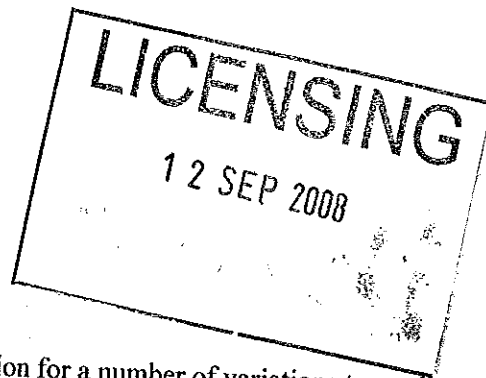
1. Signs placed at all exits regarding noise
This is already in place on all exits
2. Broken glass and bottles not to be disposed of between 9pm and 9 am
Again, this is already the case, staff are trained not to empty any crates etc after 8pm. In addition all collections of broken glass and deliveries made to the pub are instructed to do so after 9 am
3. A) windows and doors be closed when music be playing
All doors are now fitted with closers. We will have internal locks fitted to opening windows in rooms were music is being played by the time the licence is due for approval, and we have just bought air conditioning which should eliminate the need to open windows and doors.

B) Noise checks carried out and recorded
Once again, this is already a part of the nightly routine. One of the owners of the building carry out 30 minute sound checks outside the building which is recorded in a log book.
4. Specification that no food or drink be taken outside after the time agreed with the committee
At the moment we have a 9pm restriction with drinks and food. If this is extended to 10pm as requested, then we will ensure that this condition is observed and also I have taken on board the mention of starting to empty the idea a little bit earlier so it is closed on time.

I hope that this now ensures the application will be approved and look forward to hearing from you in the near future.

To Whom it may concern,

Please find enclosed the application for a number of variations to my licence. To ensure you have a clear understanding, I am taking this opportunity to give specific details regarding the variation.

The first variation is to re licence our first floor function room. The function room has always been historically licensed. We believe that the licence was not renewed for it when the new licensing act was put into place. We are proposing that the function room be licensed under the same times and conditions as the existing licence. I have enclosed a scale drawing of the function room in its present state. We are aware that due to lack of a second fire escape route at present that we will be limited to 60 persons. In order to manage this we are proposing each private function to provide a guest list prior to the party commencing. The fire authorities have recently visited the function room given us a list of works to be carried out which have all now been completed.

The second variation is to firstly, extent the time glasses can be outside from 9pm to 10pm. And also to lift the restriction completely in our new enclosed area. I have enclosed a sketch of this. The reasoning behind this is as follows. We are having problems with customers leaving drinks unattended whilst going out for a cigarette. The industry for years has taught customers not to leave drinks unattended and now we are telling them to do the opposite whist they are out side and so we are having constant confrontations with people, or they are quickly downing drinks to go and have a cigarette, which is making them binge drink, which we all know of the problems that's causing. Taking glasses outside is not making people stay outside and make noise longer, it is just making them feel safe about there drinks and drink at a sensible pace. We have made this enclosed area at the front of the pub that is only accessible from inside the pub. This will mean that no glasses and bottles can be taken off site. We will continue to monitor this area as we have done before, making people come in side if they are not smoking etc. We have designed it to act as a screen. The way we have built it should keep the noise of our customers to a minimum whilst at the same time give them some privacy from the neighbours and the busy road.

The third variation that we are proposing is to extent the supply of alcohol time on Friday evening and Saturday evening by half an hour. From midnight to 00.30 am. We are proposing this in the hope that it will allow the site to clear more easily with less disturbance. With the extra 30 minutes people will drift off when they are ready a bit more and it will give the customers more chance of getting a taxi instead of being left outside in groups on the street. Also with the ever changing shift patterns the extra little bit of time will allow more of our local community to enjoy a few drinks after work with out the need to rush drinks.

Please note, any part of the application not filled in is because we are not seeking to change it and it is as per original license.

I hope this explanation is satisfactory and you now have a clearer understanding of the reasoning behind out variation application. I look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
