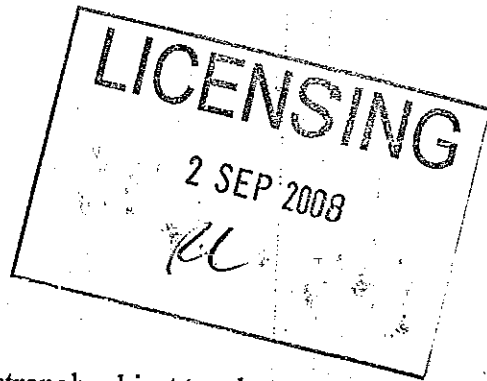
We wish to register our objection to the above premises operating as a pizza and grill.

We cannot come to terms with the noise and being woken up *every night* between 12:00am and 2:00am, seven days a week. I am therefore writing to also ask about the **enforcement of the late opening laws regarding 163 Old Chester Road, Pizza and grill** as I am informed by the Police this is an offence.

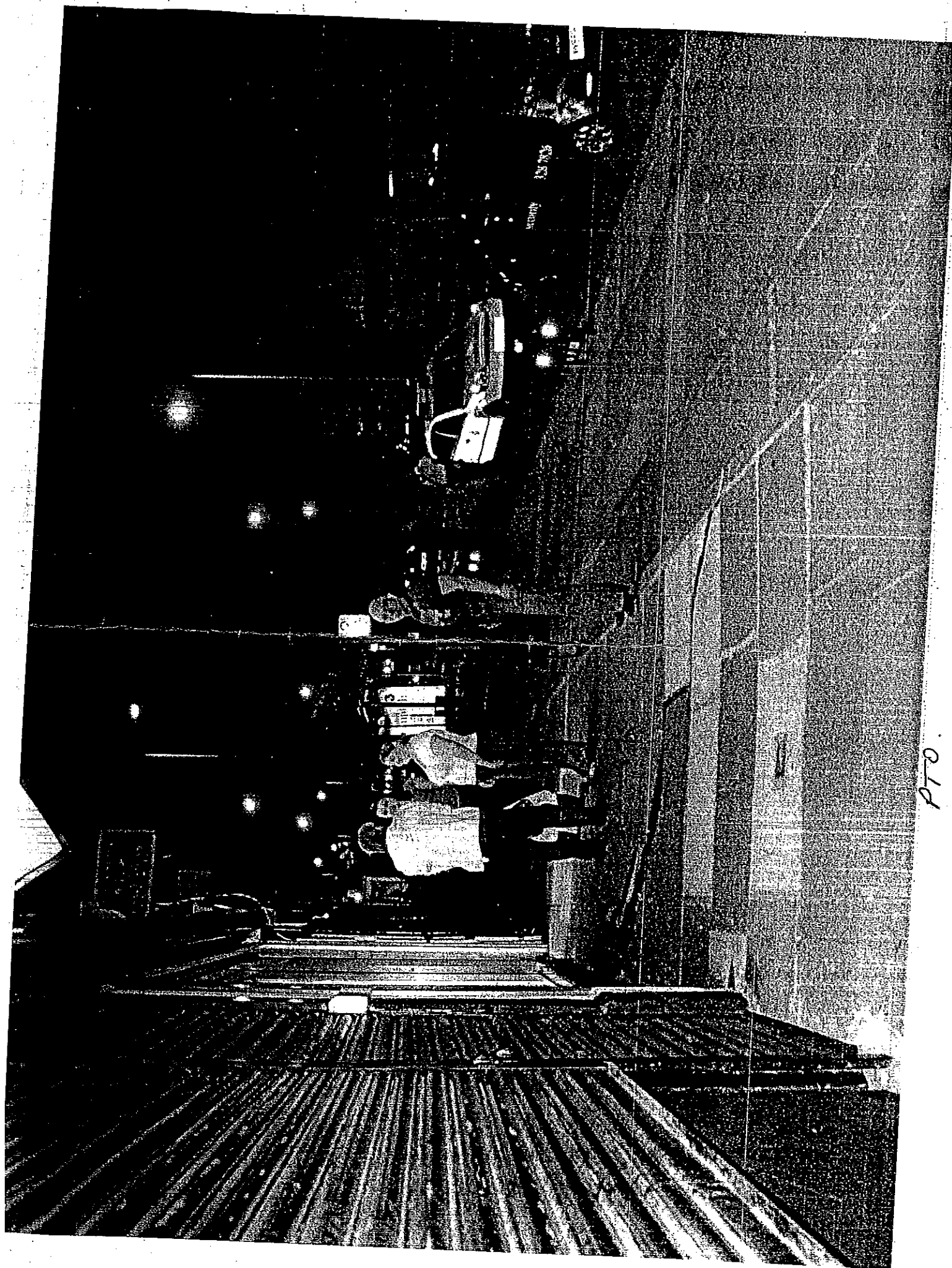
The noise from the electric shutters wakes us up every night. These go down at closing time (between 12:00am weekdays and 2:00am on Saturdays) and often up again, sometimes three or four times.

The noise from staff and pizza delivery cars is a nuisance in this largely residential area. However, it is the gangs of drunks and Police visits that cause the most disturbance. Please see enclosed photo taken at 12:15pm. I have spoken on three occasions with visiting officers who have told me that they would prefer late opening businesses contained to non residential area.

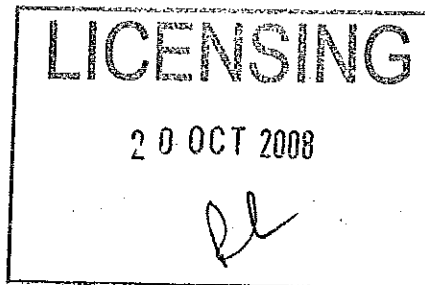

Re: Late Trading Application For 163 Old Chester Road Bebington

I am writing to object most strongly to the above application as a local resident.

This business has been trading illegally since opening in May 2008, with no regard for any of their neighbours and nearby businesses and council departments have had to visit over various issues.

They are open every night beyond their current licence, midnight during the week and 1.30am at the weekend, creating police visits, noise, litter, human waste, extra cars (with doors slamming) and gatherings of drunks. To date there has been no enforcement.

If trading is granted to 1am does this mean, given their current attitude to the law, that they will be opening until 3am or later?

They have been allowed to make three applications all being rejected due to their refusal to display the statutory notice clearly legible to the public and this only occurred after complaints and council visits. If there had not already been complaints about their conduct no one would have even known about the application and it would have passed without comment from anyone.

Their equipment, extractor fans and shutters are a statutory noise nuisance as per the recent repeat visits by the relevant council department.

As a partner in a business and as a resident the situation of being unable to use these premises for both business and residence as a direct result of the opening of this business is unacceptable.

Being unable to sleep due to the constant noise from equipment even after they eventually close is soul destroying. I am at the end of my tether and am giving serious consideration to selling up and moving away for my health and sanity, creating another vacant premises, loss of an amenity and of course job loss for the area.

The property has planning permission for a takeaway to be vacant by 11.30pm and this was adhered to by the previous tenants who closed 5 1/2 years ago. However they did give rise to the same sort of issues that have reappeared since the new business opened, but not as late. These issues could be greatly reduced by keeping the closing time earlier than the pubs thus not placing a strain on local police and street cleaning resources. Since that permission was given in 1992 the area has completely changed from a row of rundown shops, derelict houses and bedsits to a pleasant residential and retail area. The alcohol licencing law has changed giving rise to people who are drunk to be about later at night.

This area is primarily residential and late night trading is not in keeping with the location.

The rest of the shops on the rows have residents above them, or are being refitted to be let out and at least four are families with children.


The public house at the end of the row 'The Kings Arms' has recently been refused a late licence the area being residential and unsuitable for extended trading hours.

The manner in which these people have conducted themselves and their business with no cooperation leads me to make the request that a late licence is not granted for these people or indeed anyone else who may try at a later stage due to the unsuitability of the area for the business

Please advise me of the day and time of any hearing with regard to this matter and of course the outcome.

Should anyone else ever request extended trading hours on this property I request that I am informed in writing by the relevant council department.

Dear Mr Richard Leyland,

I wish to update my objection to the late license application for **163 Old Chester Road "Pizza and Grill"** after the dangerous and frightening events of this week.

1. I object to a late license being given to individuals whose shoddiness and dangerous practises led to the fire on Wednesday 15th October. If this fire had happened at a different time I don't believe we would have survived. My home still smells strongly of smoke. This fire is still being investigated by the police and fire authorities. An additional license should be out of the question to the people who put all our lives at risk.

2. The individuals working next door are dishonest and deceitful. I am willing to state that *every single night* for the past six months they have traded past legal hours. Since your phone call they have worked from the rear of the building well after 11:00pm. I can prove this with the enclosed credit card receipts. We asked a local friend to order pizza and you can see this for yourself. They have lied to you and to police officers.

I have been very well looked after this week by two Police officers, eighteen fire fighters and the department of health and safety. I am sure your decision to **not** give a late license to Mr and Mrs Geargeras will be most welcome in this neighbourhood. Any future application for a late license will have even more resistance here as we all nearly lost everything on Wednesday.

This latest objection is in addition to any previous letters from myself.

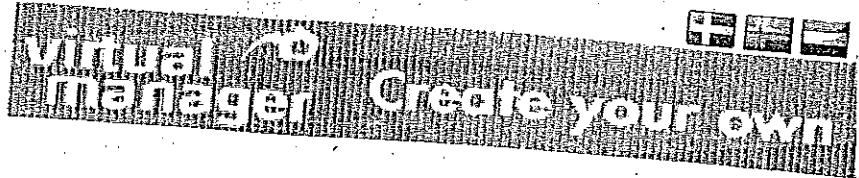

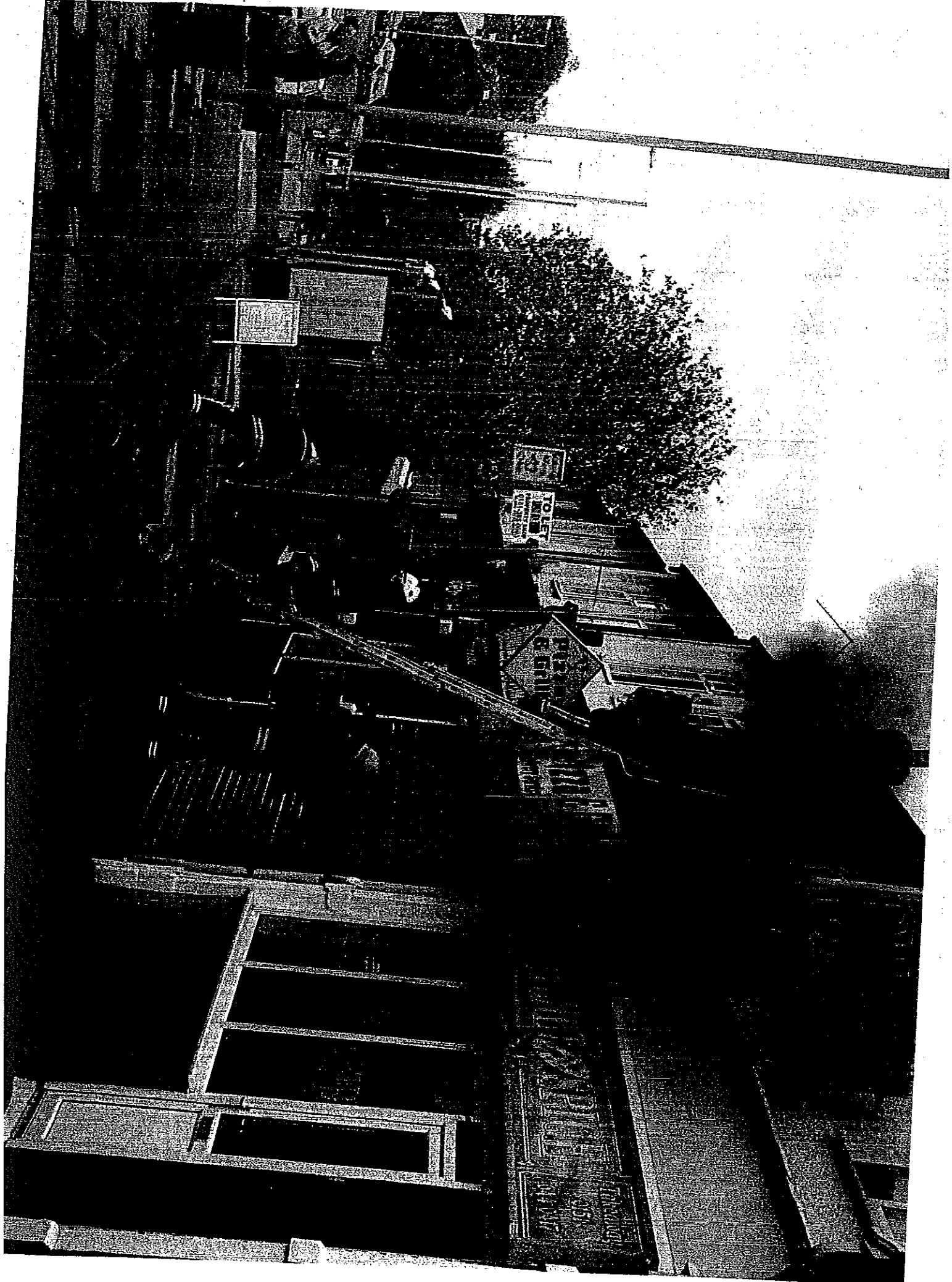

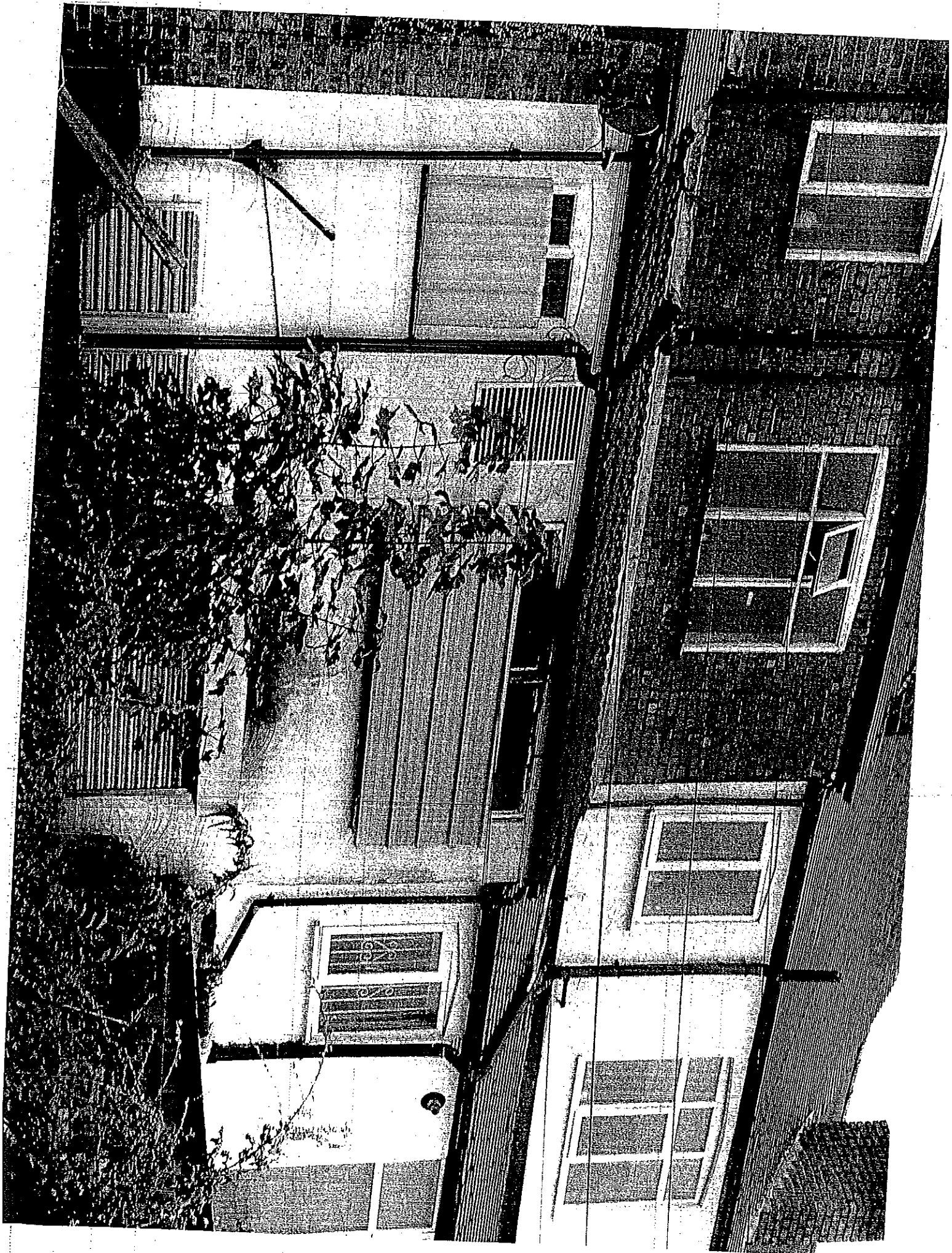
