Disturbances in Irby Village

On 3rd October many residents living in the centre of Irby witnessed problems of anti social behaviour when gangs of youths caused damage to property including broken windows and damage to property and cars.

Police believe this to be an isolated incident caused by drunken youths getting out of hand; one person was arrested and later fined for public order offences and the rest dispersed without further incident. Police and CSO patrols have been increased in the village.

We are working with the police to see if there are any practical measures that the Council can put in place to help, such as improved street lighting, cutting back of tall hedges. Please let us have your suggestions.

I wish to protest against the proposed extension to the opening hours of Irby Kebab House, until midnight on Friday and until 1 AM on Sunday morning.

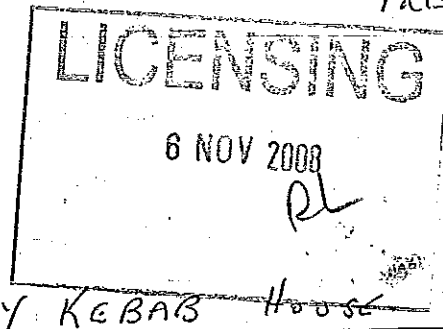
There are 3 blocks of flats within the village, plus accommodation above some of the shops. Many homes and a further block of flats, are adjacent to the village.

Reference: Extension of Opening Hours At the Kebab House, Irby Village

We would like to object to the application by the above to extend their opening hours from 11pm until midnight on weekdays and 1am on Fridays and Saturdays. Our reasons for objection are as follows:

1. There is no call for such an extension of hours by the local residents. Such an extension would only be of interest to late night revellers from outside the village.
2. Irby village still remains predominantly a quiet, residential area. Extended late night opening would result in more noise and late night disturbance.
3. Approval of extended opening hours would set a precedent for possible future applications by other take away premises. (Although in a different category, we have seen this happen in Heswall where M&S used Tesco's operating hours as one of the reasons to extend their own).

As a corollary to the above, it should be remembered that there was opposition to the Kebab House opening in Irby village as it was considered that the area was already more than well served by take away 'restaurants'. To now extend its hours of opening would just rub salt into an already open wound.

We submit that the proposal to extend the opening hours be rejected.

I strongly object to get another alcohol license in Ithy Village. There are seven alcohol outlets in this small area, i.e.

1. The Anchor, 1 Trustbuster Rd.
2. Shippans, 8A Thingwall Rd.
3. Da Pieso, 5 Mill Hill Rd.
4. Cromwells, 19 Thingwall Rd.
5. Ithy Club, Thingwall Rd.
6. Local (off licence) 14 Thingwall Rd.
7. M'Colls Store, Thingwall Rd.
8. Mahuca Bistro Thingwall Rd.

There are also three other food outlets i.e.

9. Lee + Lans, 28 B Thingwall Rd.
10. Fish + Chips, 8 Thingwall Rd.
11. Zewa Tandari 11 Thingwall Rd.

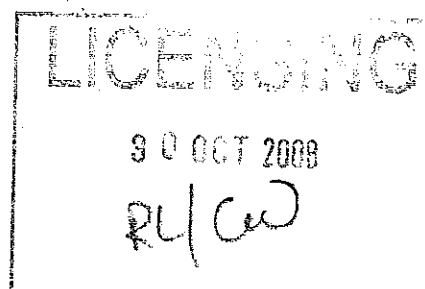

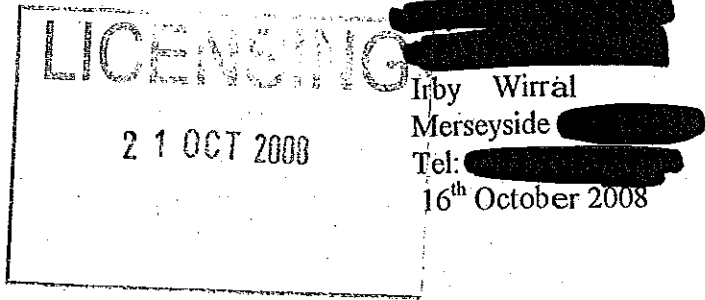

Irby has been plagued with young people who are disruptive and damage property within the village. We feel that to have another licensed premises within the village would create more problems than we already have. Further to my telephone conversation with Chris, I am writing to confirm my concerns about the application for extended opening hours for the Irby Kebab House.

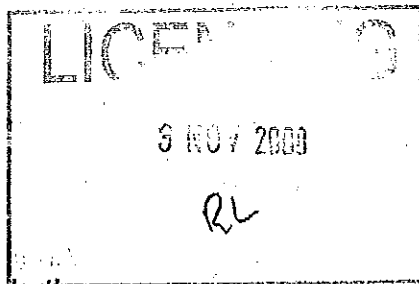
I run a [REDACTED] from the business and since the Kebab House opened there has been problems with groups of youths and anti-social behaviour, particularly on Fridays and Saturdays. Although they have been using the takeaway, I am in no way blaming the Kebab House for this behaviour; it could very well be just a coincidence.

The request to stay open later cannot be justified. Irby has always been a lovely, quiet village and there are flats above and opposite this takeaway.

I must mention that the police are dealing exceptionally well with the anti-social behaviour and are keeping us up-to-date with the proceedings. However, it is concerning the amount of time they have to now spend in the village and the cost to our local police force.

I have always supported the local businesses in the village and have no problems with the Kebab House as such but I do have a problem with the request for the extended opening hours. I might just add that on one evening when we left after 11pm, the Kebab Shop was still open – contrary to his present licence.

I would appreciate it if my details could be kept anonymous as I do not want any problems with the owner of the Kebab House.

Dear Miss Hesketh

The current trading hours that have been licensed for this business are already being flouted with the shop remaining open, serving customers, after 23:00hrs. The proprietor is actively encouraging late customers by offering meals at a discount after the end of his licensed trading hours.

Since this business has opened in the village there has been a marked increase in noise during the night with the noise of customers arriving both by vehicle and on foot causing disturbance to residents in what is a peaceful village. This includes additional conversational noise with people eating their food in the street as well as queuing up to be served.

Since this business has opened there have been several incidents each weekend that have required the intervention of the Police due to large numbers of youths from outside Irby Village attracted by the newly opened kebab shop displaying marked antisocial behaviour; smashing windows, damaging vehicles and business premises and generally terrorising elderly residents. I understand that the Police will be objecting to this application.

My property has had an increase in the amount of rubbish casually discarded at the entrance as well as being thrown over my garden wall.

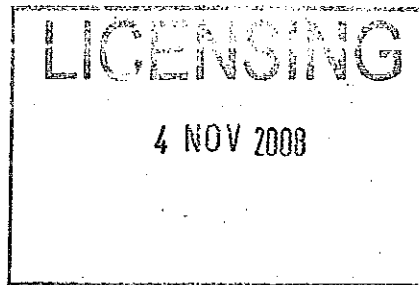
Should this application be granted the number and severity of these incidents can only increase.

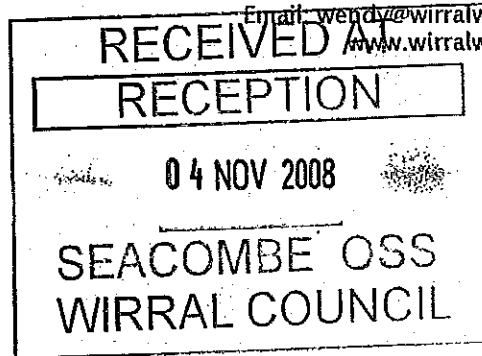

Re: 10 Thingwall Road, Irby

I am instructed by one local resident to lodge a formal representation opposing the application for a Premises Licence at 10 Thingwall Road, Irby.

My client is the spokesman for a group of residents who may wish to lodge their own representations or who may adopt the grounds set out in this letter. The representation is based on the following issues:-

- a) Opening beyond 23.00 hours on a daily basis will lead to an increase in crime and disorder. Late Night Refreshment after 23.00 hours is aimed primarily at those customers who have been drinking and who then find themselves in a very quiet neighbourhood where other licensed premises have been closed. On one Friday evening after these premises opened (in clear breach of planning permission) a large group of youths caused damage to property and stole from at least one local shop resulting in there being five Merseyside Police vehicles involved and several arrests made.
- b) There is a risk to public safety as these premises have no car park and the area immediately in front of the shop is in a pedestrian crossing zone. There is already evidence of people parking badly to visit these premises and there is therefore concern for public safety. If they are to open after 23.00 hours when many of the people concerned will have consumed alcohol.
- c) There will be an increase in public nuisance as set out in the grounds mentioned above noise, disturbance and an increase in litter will surely follow. Long hours means more obnoxious smells will be produced which will affect the whole of the area. The applicant has opened in clear breach of a planning condition which requires his fume extraction system to be built in accordance with a plan approved by the planning authority and, despite warnings, he is still trading without having conformed to that plan. There is current a noise nuisance caused by equipment

within the property and this should not be allowed to be a disturbance to neighbours at all let alone beyond the current 23.00 terminal hour.

- d) Increases noise and disturbance after 23.00 hours will keep people, including children, awake and therefore cause harm to children.


I reserve the right to add to or vary these representations.

Evidence will be called but although the applicant has been told by Wirral Borough Council officers from two departments at least that his terminal hour is 23.00 hours he has consistently since opening (in breach of planning conditions as stated above) stayed open until well after midnight. He shows unwillingness to confirm to properly imposed regulation and therefore any application to increase his hours of opening should be refused.

It is appreciated that planning conditions are not relevant in applications for Premises Licences but we will be asking officers from the Environmental Health Department and Planning Department to confirm continuing breaches of conditions as demonstrating the likely outcome of any extension of hours.

Please acknowledge safe receipt and when considering fixing a date our Mr Holland would be most grateful if he could be consulted in order to avoid diary clashes.

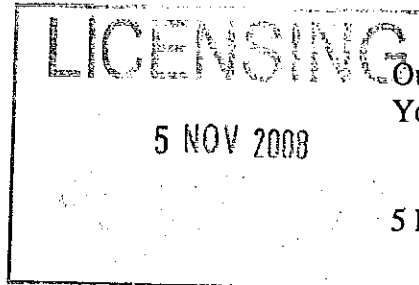


We also enclose photocopies of logs sheets provided by Wirral Borough Council and completed by our client in connection with noise nuisance emanating from the application site. The originals of these sheets are with the Environmental Health Department and copies have been sent to the planning enforcement officer. These documents are produced to show

the closing time of the application site from which you will see that on only one occasion between the 29th September and 25th October did the premises close at the time stated in the planning permission and thus was serving Late Night Refreshment illegally on all the other days. We understand that the applicant has been warned by the Environmental Health Department, the Planning Department and your department not to open beyond the hours stated in his planning permission and this is the result.

These notes were made by our client's family who occupy both as a home and the business the adjoining premises. This evidence suggests that the applicant does not comply with conditions and that the grant of a premises licence (despite matching planning permission) may lead to further public disturbance. On a similar point the planning permission granted indicated that an extract system in accordance with an approved plan had to be in place prior to opening. The applicant has opened and traded the premises in contravention of this condition. It is appreciated that planning and premises licensing are separate issues but the Committee should be aware of the way in which this applicant behaves hence the production of this information. We reserve the right to produce at the hearing evidence of late opening which we are told is still continuing.

May I add my voice to the many objections you will no doubt have received regarding the above planning application.

Having been forced to accept the Council's earlier decision to grant the application enabling the kebab shop to open for business, I and many other Irby residents, are now distressed at the prospect of the business being allowed to extend its opening hours to midnight or later. Irby is a small, generally quiet and peaceful village and we fear this peace will suffer if permission is granted.

Observation shows that, although not exclusively so, kebab-eaters tend to be in the younger age group, rather than the older, and it is this age group which also tends to be the most rowdy, troublesome and, I regret to say, less conscientious with the responsible disposal of litter. In short, we think it probable that late opening will bring a lot of noisy young people - many of whom at that time will have spent the night drinking in public houses - into the village, causing upset to residents and an inevitable increase in litter and/or worse.

I do not object to reasonable opening hours as kept responsibly by the other eating establishments in the village, but I do object most strongly to midnight or later. This goes against the established culture of our village and will affect our wellbeing - for which the Council has a duty of care.
