1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1.1 The purpose of this report is to consider an application for the review of a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by Merseyside Police and relates to the premises known as the **Poulton Pop In, 411-413 Poulton Road, Wallasey**.

2.0 BACKGROUND AND KEY ISSUES

2.1 These premises currently have a Premises Licence with the following Licensable Activity:

Sale by Retail of Alcohol

Sunday to Saturday 08:00 to 23:00

The Premises Licence currently permits the sale of alcohol for consumption Off the premises only.

Hours Open to the Public

Sunday to Saturday 06:00 to 23:00

2.2 The Licensing Act 2003 Sub-Committee may, having regard to the application for review and any relevant representations, take such of the following steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- Modify the Conditions of the Licence.
- Exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the Licence.
- Remove the Designated Premises Supervisor.
- Suspend the Licence for a period not exceeding three months.
- Revoke the Licence.

The licensing authority may decide that no action is appropriate if it finds that the review does not require it to take any steps that are appropriate to promote the licensing objectives.

3.0 APPLICATION

- 3.1 An application has been received from Merseyside Police to review the Premises Licence for the premises known as Poulton Pop In. The Licensing Sergeant has advised that the grounds for review relate to the Premises knowingly employing an individual who cannot lawfully be employed in the UK, which has led to the crime and disorder licensing objective being undermined.
- 3.2 There have been no representations received from the following Responsible Authorities or from any other person.
