## REPORT SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to consider an application for a Review of a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by the Licensing Authority and relates to the premises known as One Stop News and Booze, 102 Vittoria Street, Birkenhead.

#### **Hours Open to the Public**

Sunday to Saturday 07:00 to 23:00

- 3.2 The Licensing Act 2003 Sub-Committee may, having regard to the application for a Review and any relevant representations, take such of the following steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:
  - Modify the Conditions of the Licence.
  - Exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the Licence.
  - Remove the Designated Premises Supervisor.
  - Suspend the Licence for a period not exceeding three months.
  - Revoke the Licence.

The licensing authority may decide that no action is appropriate if it finds that the Review does not require it to take any steps that are appropriate to promote the licensing objectives.

#### 3.3 APPLICATION

- 3.4 An application has been received from the Licensing Authority to review the Premises Licence for the premises known as One Stop News and Booze. The grounds for review are in relation to the sale of alcohol being sold outside of the hours permitted by the Premises Licence, breaches of the Premises Licence conditions and the premises employing an individual who is not permitted to work in the UK.
- 3.5 Further information to support the above grounds for the Review is included within the application which is available.
