





When a planning application was made recently to construct an open air terrace to the rear of this establishment I objected because I was concerned that, given its upper storey elevation in combination with the relative openness of its aspect and the prevailing wind direction from the south-west, unwelcome noise would drift across the rear of my home during the early hours of the morning.

My concerns have been realised and heavy thumping sounds coming from the direction of the Latin Quarter regularly disturb me late at night and, at weekends, well into the "wee hours" of the morning.

I therefore object very strongly to the proposal to increase opening hours on Sunday mornings on the basis that my living conditions would be adversely affected. Whilst I accept that the level of noise generated may not constitute a statutory nuisance, which licensing laws seek to prevent, I nevertheless consider the effect to be of sufficient concern in Planning terms to justify refusal of any concurrent or subsequent application to vary the opening hours condition on the existing planning application.

In the course of your deliberations, I humbly request, therefore, that you please share these concerns of mine with your colleagues in the Local Planning Authority.

The premises are also seeking that the entertainment is allowed to continue for an extra hour on a Saturday.</p> <p>These premises have a history of incidents many of which involve violence. Extra alcohol consumption over extended hours has the capacity to increase crime and disorder. The hours applied for are excessive given the recent history of incidents at the location.</p> <p>The following is a list of incidents over the last 6 months only. At the hearing the Sub committee accepted that the later hours combined with poor management had resulted in increased crime and disorder. The hours were reduced to 0400 hrs. On Saturday 8th November 2008 at approximately 03:05 hours I was on uniformed mobile patrol in company with Constable 5306 ROLES.

At this time we were patrolling in the Birkenhead town centre area when we were informed by the Wirral Control room that a male had recently been assaulted by another male in the Latin Quarter, Conway Street, Birkenhead, and the offender had made off in the direction of DACRE STREET. As soon as we heard this information Constable 5306 ROLES turned our police vehicle into DACRE STREET and I was able to notice a male walking towards our vehicle on the left hand side of the pavement. Our vehicle was stopped and I alighted to speak to the male, in doing so I immediately recognised the male to be [REDACTED] from previous dealings. I proceeded to question the male why he was in the street and he was unable to

provide a clear explanation. Moments later I was joined by other uniformed colleagues who informed me that [REDACTED] fitted the description of the offender provided by the aggrieved, I was also informed that the complainant in the matter has sustained a cut lip and had been knock unconsciousness from the assault.

I looked at [REDACTED] right hand and I could see that it had blood on his second knuckle. I then cautioned and arrested him on suspicion of section 47 assault. He made no reply. [REDACTED] was placed into the rear of our police vehicle and handcuffed to the front, they were checked for fit and double locked for his safety. As we drove along DACRE STREET, we turned into BURRLINGTON STREET and stopped to speak to the other officers. Moments later a male appeared out of a parked ambulance and walked over to our police vehicle and stated towards me, "THAT'S HIM, 100%"

On Friday 1st August 2008 I was out drinking in Birkenhead with my brother [REDACTED] (15/06/84) who lives at the same address as me, my girlfriends [REDACTED] & [REDACTED], New Brighton and my brother's girlfriend [REDACTED] who also lives at my home address. The four of us had been drinking locally in USGARD and then got a taxi down to THE LATIN QUARTER in BIRKENHEAD. We must have arrived at THE LATIN QUARTER at about 11pm.

We went straight into THE LATIN QUARTER and up to the bar I paid for me and vodka to get in and began to walk to the bar - Julie went to the toilet. At this time my brother and his girlfriend were still paying to get in and I walked straight into a group of males at the bar. I had both of my hands in the back pockets of my jeans because I was getting my wallet out. All of a sudden

without any provocation I could see a fist coming towards my face and I was able to see that standing to my left was [REDACTED] and it was him punching me. His fist hit me on the left side of my mouth. This punch knocked me out and I fell backwards, my elbows broke my fall because my hands were still in my back pockets.

I do not know how long I was knocked out for, nor do I really know what happened after Corredon punched me. The next thing that I remember was being put into a taxi with my brother and our girlfriends. We then returned home.

The injuries that I have are both of my elbows are bruised and swollen and aching all of the time. I have a a bruise and slight cut to my left wrist just above my handphone. I do not know how I got this injury but it was not there when I got dressed for the evening, nor was my side sore at all before this incident. As a result of the punch two of my teeth have been damaged. The teeth are lower jaw front teeth. One tooth has been completely broken about $\frac{2}{3}$ two thirds from the top and the one next to it has been chipped. The broken tooth has the nerve exposed and due to this it is very painful. I could not eat at all on Saturday 2nd August 2008 and I have only been able to eat a small amount of food this evening but it was very painful. I have

also got a sore neck. Also the inside of my top lip on my left hand side of my mouth is cut.

This morning I attended ~~WALLASEY~~ WALK-IN CENTRE on MILL LANE. I had to have an x-ray on my left elbow to ensure it ~~wasn't~~ broken at all. The doctor at the centre advised me to take ibuprofen for the pain and he advised that I get dental treatment as soon as possible.

Due to the fact that I have only recently come out of the Navy I do not currently have a dentist so I have got to try to see an emergency dentist. However, I will need to pay for any treatment that I need. Because I leave work at 06.30 every day and do not get home until about 19.00 hours it will be difficult for me to get to a dentist. I can not take time off work due to the fact that recently ^{due to} a member of family being ill and a bereavement I needed a lot of time off. So this makes getting a dentist appointment more difficult.

I know [REDACTED] because in the past I have been assaulted by him which resulted in him attending court over that matter.

The Victim personal statement has been explained to me. I have included in this statement details of how [REDACTED] injured me and the inconvenience and pain caused in waiting for and eventually getting the necessary treatment I would like.
