The prevention of crime and disorder	Y	<p>This is a new application for a premises licence that is seeking to sell alcohol from 0600 hrs to 2300 hrs. These premises previously applied for a licence in February 2008. Representations were made by Merseyside Police on the grounds that the vicinity is an area of high anti social behaviour and the granting of a licence for alcohol would increase the disorder and undermine the licensing objectives. The application was also opposed by local residents and councillors and was refused at a hearing on 28th February 2008.</p> <p>These premises are located in a small row of shops within a large housing estate. In respect of this latest application I have again sought the opinion of Inspector Griffiths who is the neighbourhood Inspector for the area. He tells me that this continues to be an area that suffers from high anti social behaviour and he continues to deploy numerous resources to the vicinity. Anti social behaviour problems particularly related to alcohol are always the most complained about matter at community meetings. I attach a record of Police incidents in the immediate area and</p>

	<p>point out that this relates to the winter months and would be expected to be considerably higher during the summer months.</p> <p>Inspector Griffiths reports alcohol seizures from young persons in the vicinity as follows:-</p> <p>November 2008 - 21 litres cider/30 cans lager/2 bottles vodka December 2008 – 12 litres coder/63 cans lager January 2009 – 18 litres cider/81 cans lager/1 whisky/1 vodka February 2009 – 21 cans cider/77 cans lager/1 bottle vodka</p> <p>It is strongly believed that the opening of an off licence in the vicinity would considerably add to this problem both as an outlet for alcohol to be obtained from but additionally as a magnet for youths to congregate.</p> <p>I suggest that the application be refused on the grounds of crime and disorder.</p>

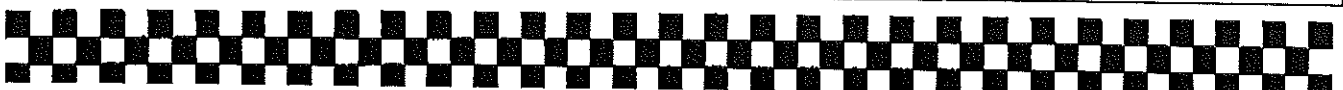

I am Police Community Support and Traffic Officer 0052 Sharon Broderick of Merseyside Police. I am currently stationed at Upton Police Station and am part of the dedicated policing team covering the Woodchurch estate (A416/417). I have patrolled this area on high visibility foot patrol for the last two years, engaging with businesses, residents, youths and partner organisations.

During 2007 I, along with other members of them received numerous complaints from businesses and residents in the Eltham Green area of the Woodchurch estate relating to youth alcohol misuse and anti-social behaviour as a result of this. During this period and into the first quarter of 2008 police received an increased number of calls to the area, compared with the same period in previous years.

As a result of this increase in calls and crimes such as Criminal Damage, Assaults etc. I put a S.A.R.A in place, in order to attempt to increase public satisfaction and reduce crime and ASB.



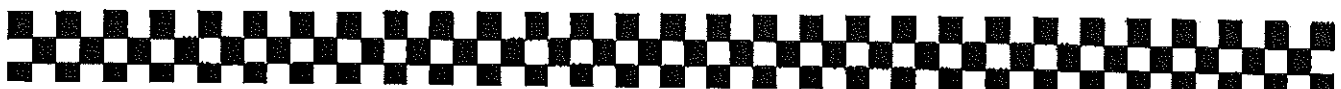
I identified a specific youth group responsible for the incidents and gathered intelligence in relation to the youth's access to purchasing alcohol within the local area. I engaged with partner organisations including Youth Services and voluntary youth groups, Social Partnership and Wood church High School.

An Alcohol awareness day was organised at Wood church High school and every pupil in the identified year group was spoken to by various organisations throughout the day. This was then reinforced throughout the academic year with myself and various agencies' having input at not only this year group's assembly but at various assemblies' at the school.

I worked closely with youth providers in the area and initially clean up's where organised to engage the youth and increase their feeling of responsibility for the area. Some of the events included litter picks, graffiti removal and community garden development. Operation Wishing Well was developed and funded by P.A.Y.E.E.S + money. During this operation about 50 youths of the problem year group where targeted to make wishing well planters to distribute on the estate. Wood church High School, Fender and S.N.A.P youth clubs engaged along with Holy Cross Church who had seen an increase of criminal damage and YCA on the grounds. About 40 planters where made during the weeklong operation in the Halloween half term. Following on from this success, various other projects where organised including the making of Bat and Bird boxes for the developed community gardens on Hoole Road, operation bench mark which engaged youths in making garden furniture for elderly residents on the estate and then followed up with the creation of a community garden for the residents of Brackendale (a high rise mature tenanted block of flats on New Hey Road) .

A system was also introduced through the five youth service providers on the estate to develop out-reach support in identified locations at times of high volume complaints and calls to police. This has proved very successful and has seen a dramatic reduction in such calls. Other

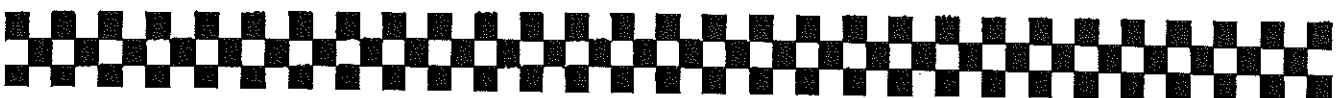

systems have also been put into place some of these include continued events and assembly's at Wood church High School, a red and yellow card system for participation in diversionary activities and a joined up approach to youth facilities on the estate. This has enabled youth providers to ensure good behaviour is sustained throughout the youth facilities and the Estate in general. Rewards of trips to Alton Towers, Camelot, Knowsley's Safari Park and Tall Ship's are offered to those who participate fully in the operations and sustain good behaviour.

This joined up approach to the problems arising through youth disorder and youth alcohol misuse has seen dramatic reduction in calls and complaints reported to police. I feel that any further premises selling alcohol in the area could have a detrimental effect on this positive working relationship developed between businesses, partner agency's, youth's, residents and the wider community in general. As it may increase underage youths ability to get access to alcohol and therefore may lead to an increase in calls and complaints again.

I confirm that the above statement is the truth to the best of my knowledge. I am willing to attend court in relation to this matter and will abide by the decision of the Chief Constable.

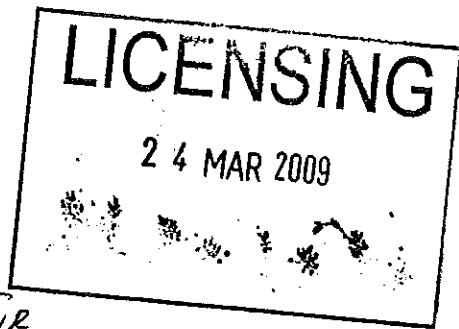

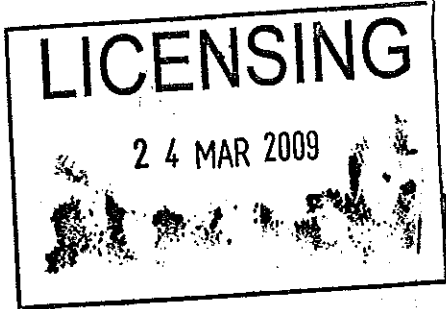



'Let off' for drink sales to children

MORE shopkeepers are escaping prosecution for selling alcohol to children, disturbing new figures show.

The number caught breaking the law on serving under-age customers rose by a third from 2004 to 2007.

But prosecutions have fallen sharply because far more are being given 80 fixed notices – described by critics as little more than a slap on the wrist.

It comes as other figures show thousands of children are being admitted to hospital every year with mental disorders linked to alcohol misuse.

Since 2005, Gordon Brown has twice promised to get tough on those selling drink to children.

As many as 800,000 under-18s have bought alcohol in shops, pubs and bars in the past year, it is estimated.

However, in 2006-07, the last year for which figures are available, the number of licensees taken to court for breaking the law fell by 42 per cent from 1,199 to 693. Between 2004 and 2007, the number given a fixed penalty ticket rose by 74 per cent.

These figures show that government promises to crack down on under-age drinking are completely empty, said Don Foster, culture spokesman for the Liberal Democrats, who obtained the

figures. The Metropolitan Police Federation said a shopkeeper fined £80 could make his money back by selling just a few cases of lager.

Chairman Peter Smyth said: "If you allow strong alcohol in the wrong hands it can lead to all sorts of problems such as violence, other crimes and anti-social behaviour."

Other figures reveal that 1,043 under-14s were taken to hospital with mental health problems linked to alcohol last year.

Another 223 children aged 13 and 14 were admitted to hospital.

The British Retail Consortium said shopkeepers were increasingly challenging people to show proof of age.

A spokesman said: "The problem of under-18s buying alcohol from shops is being reduced."

Yesterday, ministers shied away from a call by chief medical officer Sir Liam Donaldson to impose minimum prices on drink.

Work and pensions secretary James Purnell said the government did not want to punish the majority for the sins of the minority.

Cheap alcohol blamed for Britain's hangover

BRITAIN has a drinking problem and tough measures are needed to tackle it, the chief medical officer said yesterday.

Cheap alcohol and ready availability are key factors behind the increase in drinking and associated problems such as crime and welfare, he warned.

Measures to control price and access need to be the backbone of any plan aimed at addressing the problem, he added.

Let's try to imagine a county where nobody is physically or sexually abused because of alcohol. Imagine a county

where nobody dies in an accident caused by alcohol," Sir Liam said.

He recommended that a minimum price of 50p per unit of alcohol should be introduced to cut consumption.

This would cut deaths by road traffic accidents by 10 per cent and crime by 10 per cent, he said.

However, Gordon Brown distanced him self from Sir Liam's comments, saying

there were no plans to penalise the majority of drinkers who drink sensibly.

We have taken action to tackle binge and underage drinking, the prime minister said.

We also do not want the responsible sensible majority of moderate drinkers to have to pay more, he added.

Conservative leader David Cameron also said taxes should be raised on high strength beers and cider.



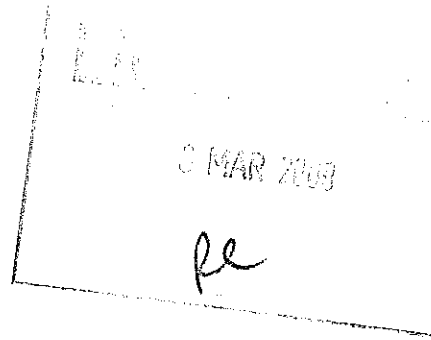
We object to the application of an Alcohol Licence being granted for the following reasons:



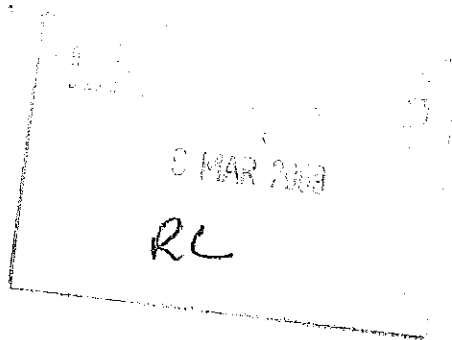

I feel that the area does not need another alcohol outlet. We already have Asda and Sainsburys which sell alcohol that people can consume at home. The area also in close proximity - The Cherry Orchard, - The Arrow Park Hotel - and the Stirrup Pubs if people wish to go out for a drink.

There has been a history in the area of teenagers hanging around and causing trouble with anti-social behaviour such as vandalism of property, street drinking and intimidation of people going about their normal business. If this alcohol outlet is permitted this will cause teenagers to hang around outside and attempt to buy alcohol.

I am aware of other local opposition to the application, and I urge you to reject the application in the interests of the local community.

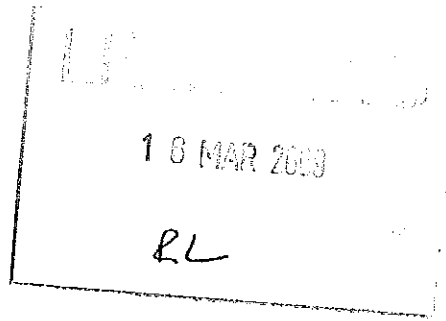

The shop is called **Best One Express** address: **45 – 47 Fleetcroft Road, Arrowe Park CH49 5LZ**. The owner **Mr Perinparajah Amalraj** applied this time last year and there was a great deal of opposition then and I have no doubt we will have the same again so why on earth should you even consider it. We already have a very good newsagent/post office that also sells some convenience food. As with the previous application by Mr. Perinparjah Amalraj, proprietor of the above named premises, I hereby register my objection to the granting of a licence to sell alcohol at these premises.

The following reasons are given:

Firstly, the initial application was denied by the licensing committee. To the best of my knowledge, none of the original grounds for denial have changed.

At the original meeting great concern was expressed that the opening of these premises would introduce an element of attraction to youths. This concern has now been born out, as it has been noted that during the summer months after the opening of the shop, a far greater number of youths had been seen congregating outside of the shops. It was also noted that the wall immediately outside the premises was being used by an increased number of people as a seating area for the consumption of products purchased from the shops.

With respect to the gathering of youths outside the premises, I clearly remember one of the representatives for "The Best One" stating that if there were an increase in the numbers of youths gathering outside the premises then they themselves would undertake to disperse them. I personally have no evidence of this happening at any time. With respect to this I notice that there has now been a CCTV camera installed opposite the Chemist adjacent to the "Best One". While this is to be applauded, it has only served to force the troublesome element of youths to move to the car parks and garage areas, where large amounts of broken glass can be seen. I mention this purely for the benefit of the police who I assume will be present again at the application hearing.

As I myself will be unable to attend the application meeting on this occasion, please could I ask for somebody on my behalf to ask the following question.

"If Mr. Perinparjah Amalraj genuinely wishes to supply a community retail outlet to serve the needs of the local people, then surely it would be in his and everybody else's best interests, if he were to listen and be guided by the wishes and opinions, expressed at the previous, and current licensing application hearing. a) Meadowside School - is a purpose built school for children and young people with physical disabilities

b) Holy Cross C of E is for children from nursery to eleven years old. These students and young ones do not need to be placed in a position where they can be in a shop, after school maybe buying sweets & crisps, with people buying alcohol

G - Holy Cross Church.

Which obviously has specific times for Mass and Communion Services and also funerals.

and again I can show you evidence of alcohol abuse - evenings and week-ends - and that evidence is carrier bags from the supermarkets, broken glass all over the road and in the grass and surrounding areas. We have ASDA, SAINSBURY'S, and off licences in Greatby, Upton Woodchurch, Thurgwall lby all selling alcohol all within 5-10mins away.

I have a dog and walk in Amrose Park every day, two/three times a day. I can show you areas where people - young men and women, some clearly underage, drink and/or drinking. Again there are carrier bags from the super markets and off-licences strewn everywhere - broken bottles and glasses in the wooded areas and on the paths.

Broken glass bottles of vodka, coke, cider and of course the plastic bottles. The men who work in the park will tell you of the amount of black bags full of rubbish these people leave and then the amount of glass.

These youngsters also intimidate people walking in a public park; with their families and pets, they are on push-bikes, scrambling bikes and even quad bikes, they rip up the turf, and cause a lot of anguish. I am not saying that all these problems would be made worse by BEST ONE being granted a Premises Licence but I know in my heart that these problems would be made worse.

If they are only to be installed after the licence has been granted, does that not tell you that by granting the licence Best One know that the licence will bring with it more trouble both to Best One and Fleetcroft Road and the surrounding areas)

Please do not grant this licence for Best One to sell alcohol, the whole country has major problems with Supermarkets and off licences selling alcohol to underage drinkers.

Only this week-end Professor Jon Gunn of Royal Liverpool University Hospital - has called for the Government to behave much more responsibly - to the selling of alcohol - He and Chief Medical Officer of Health have asked for an increase in the price of alcohol - as Scotland have. The Supermarkets and off-licences are selling alcohol cheaper than a pint of milk! Whilst liver disease, Carcinoma of the Stomach, lungs, liver and oesophagus are on the increase -

To say nothing of the social problems that alcohol causes, i.e., marriage breakdowns, battered wives, husbands and children, the physical, mental, sexual, verbal abuse that alcohol and drugs cause.

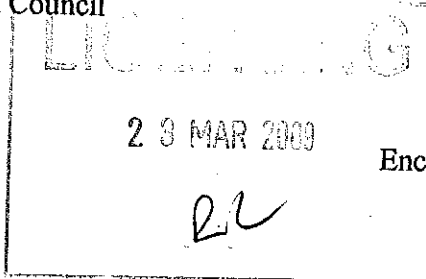

Dear Sir/Madame

I right as chairman and director of the Childwall Green Residents (Right to Manage Co) Ltd. This is the property management company responsible for the 10 blocks comprising 90 flats located at the corner of Poole lane and running along the Arrowe Park Road terminating close to the Arrowe Park Public house. The flats hereafter called the development can be easily located as those opposite the Arrowe park hospital.

The company is a residents run organisation. There are some 170 residents in total.

I right to object on behalf of the residents of the development who are now once again deeply concerned over the appeal lodged by "Best One" to overturn the previous decision which was made not to grant a license to sell alcohol. This decision was made by the council committee chaired by Cllr Chris Teggin. The meeting was extremely well attended by the local community with Cllr Chris Teggin stating both at the meeting and in the press that "it was the best attended meeting he had ever seen" adding in the reported press "existing problems with anti-social behaviour and young people gaining access to alcohol would be made worse by it being granted approval".

Clearly the decision not to grant an alcohol licence was the correct one on many levels which was supported by Cllr Sue Brown, Police Inspector Brian Griffiths and S Hesford MP with his assistant representing him at the meeting. It came as a great relief to all the local residents who were delighted with the outcome.

The reasons for the objection to the appeal are basically unchanged from the objections stated in the letter previously sent apposing the original application for a licence to sell alcohol.

Granting an alcohol licence would in the residents opinion exacerbate the problems associated with alcohol being easily available to the local youths. The local residents see evidence of both alcohol and drug use on a regular basis and the two problems commonly go hand in hand.

Therefore the residents see no good reason as to why the appeal should be upheld and a licence to sell alcohol granted on appeal. They feel that nothing has changed that would warrant the granting of a licence and would be greatly dismayed if a licence was issued.


We still suffer from used alcohol containers thrown into the gardens by youths waiting for public transport even though a waste bin is provided close to the bus stop and youths creating a problems late in the evenings which a good part is alcohol related and it is felt that this problem will only increase if a licence is granted.

Only last week we were reminded of the prevalent alcohol problem caused by easily available cheap alcohol. The government was urged to charge 50 pence per unit of alcohol purchased with the idea being supported by some doctors who stated that £3 billion per year is spent on treating alcohol related disease by the NHS.

There is no shortage of retail outlets selling all forms of alcohol in the area. The youths who wish to purchase alcohol and live locally do not in the main purchase from the supermarkets but prefer to purchase from local small licensed outlets.

The local press (Wirral Globe, reporter Jane Moss) reporting on the outcome of the meeting held in public at the town hall headlined "**People power wins the day**" please do not allow alcohol power have the last say!

Not to mention the fact that the notice has been placed about six to seven feet high which makes it very difficult for the smaller members of our society such as myself to even notice it much less be able to read it.

Surely the applicant has a duty to make sure that such a notice is **CLEARLY VISIBLE**

Secondly the public notice for this application has been placed in the Wirral News paper which isn't even delivered to this area. The Wirral News is delivered in the likes of Heswall, Hoylake and Wallasey.

Why would a resident from these areas have any interest in an alcohol licence application for the Woodchurch area?

Why wasn't the notice placed in the Wirral globe which is delivered to our area?

Now on to the matter of my objection and I would like to re-iterate some of the points I made in my letter of last year when the previous application for these premises was refused.

As I stated then I have lived here in my home since a child in the early seventies and I am now my elderly mothers sole and full time carer.

Approximately fifteen years ago when this precinct had premises selling alcohol this area was subjected to some of the worst acts of vandalism and anti social behaviour I have ever seen. Walls were regularly smashed down, drainpipes were pulled off walls and grids located within it either had their covers removed or were deliberately blocked up with stones and litter so that they overflowed. The nearby primary school was also regularly attacked and we endured many nights with the alarm being triggered.

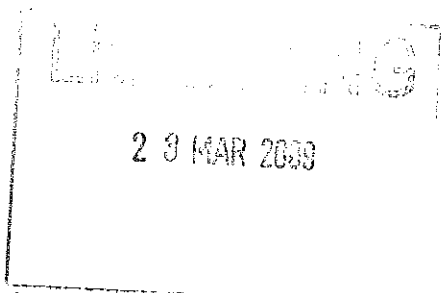
Nowadays it is somewhat quieter, but my biggest fear is that if this licence is granted youngsters will once again flock to this area in groups of twenty or thirty to participate in underage drinking. I have no doubt that the appalling acts of vandalism and anti-social behaviour we suffered in the past will return and possibly be even worse than previously, with knife crime now a major concern.

With the current abuse and misuse of alcohol in our society, with NHS hospitals struggling to cope with admissions due to alcohol abuse, with police unable to respond to many calls due to lack of manpower, it is for people like me of moderate intelligence incomprehensible how we can possibly carry on allowing more and more outlets to sell alcohol. We should be encouraging people to drink in a more responsible manner. Worse still with the council about to close down a number of libraries, social and sporting venues there are going to be even fewer places for our young people to go which I believe will lead to more problems with youngsters hanging around the streets drinking.

With these comments in mind I would URGE you to think of residents who live in the immediate vicinity of this precinct and REFUSE THIS APPLICATION.
