Bank Holiday Friday, Saturday and Sundays, Maundy Thursday, Christmas Eve, Boxing Day, St Valentine's Day and St Patrick's Day.

New Years Eve: 10.00am to 10.00am the following day for the Supply of Alcohol and Hours Open to the Public and Regulated Entertainment to be extended to 30 minutes before closing time.
