Play Champion Job Description

Objectives of Post

To champion and raise the profile of children's play across Wirral

To promote play-friendly environments for children and young people on Wirral across a range of needs and abilities

To be influential in decision making regarding children's play

To support the Play Partnership to meet its aims and objectives

To engage, interact and communicate on a variety of levels with children, young people, communities and other agencies across Wirral to ensure their views are heard listened to and acted upon, with the support of the Partnership

To advocate the child's right to play, in line with the UN Convention on The Rights of The Child

Person Specification

Ability to relate to children, young people, parents, carers and community members of all ages and abilities within Wirral

Commitment to the development of play opportunities for all children and young people on Wirral

Excellent verbal communication skills and confident public speaker

Commitment to regularly meet with Wirral's children and young people

Commitment to the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child
