| Labour | 51.82 rounded to | 52 |
| :--- | ---: | :---: |
| Conservative | 29.36 rounded to | 29 |
| Green | 22.45 rounded to | $23^{*}$ |
| Liberal Democrat | 10.36 rounded to | $\frac{10}{114}$ |

To achieve overall proportionality, the Conservative group has relinquished seats on Economy, Regeneration and Housing Committee and Regulatory and General Purposes Committee to the Green group.
*As traditional rounding provides a total allocation of 113 seats, the largest decimal point originally rounded down is rounded up to provide 114 seats.
