REPORT SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to consider an Objection Notice that has been submitted by Environmental Health in respect of a Temporary Event Notice under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The proposed Premises User is **Charlie Parsons** and the Temporary Event Notice relates to the premises known as **625**, **86 Banks Road**, **West Kirby**, **Wirral CH48 0RE**.

RECOMMENDATION

The Licensing Act Sub-Committee are asked to determine whether the Licensing Authority should issue a Counter Notice to the Temporary Event Notice following the submission of an Objection Notice by Environmental Health.
