## 35 **HONORARY FREEDOM OF THE BOROUGH (POSTHUMOUS AWARD) GLENDA JACKSON**

The Council considered a report from the Director of Law and Governance in respect to a proposal to admit posthumously, Glenda Jackson, as an Honorary Freewoman of the Borough.

The recommendation was in pursuance of the provisions of Section 249 (5) of the Local Government Act 1972 and in recognition of her dedicated service to

the Borough, that Glenda Jackson be posthumously admitted as Honorary Freewoman of this Borough.

Several Councillors spoke of the achievements of Glenda Jackson, outlining her upbringing in Wirral before her move to London and the significant contributions she made to acting and politics.

Following the speeches from Councillors, it was –
