Resolved - That, having considered carefully all the evidence, the Appeals Sub-Committee upholds the appeal and,

- (ii) the appellant receive a final written warning and that if he repeats his acts of misconduct or commits any further acts of misconduct whatsoever he be dismissed unless there are truly exceptional circumstances. That the final written warning continue for 12 months and that it might be also be taken into account after that period has elapsed if the appellant subsequently commits any further acts of misconduct.
