1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to consider an application to vary a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by **Greene King Retailing Limited** and relates to the premises known as **The Bromborough, 2 Bromborough Village Road, Bromborough.**

Regulated Entertainment (Live Music, Recorded Music and Anything of a Similar Description)

Sunday to Thursday 11:00 to 23:00
Friday and Saturday 11:00 to 00:00

Late Night Refreshment

Sunday to Thursday 23:00 to 23:30
Friday and Saturday 23:00 to 00:00

3.0 APPLICATION

- 3.1 The application to vary the Premises Licence is to remove the following conditions:

- Children must not be allowed on site after 20:00
- No tables and chairs shall be available in the smoking area.

- To remove all conditions listed in the Public Entertainment Licence conditions.

3.2 Following consultation with Environmental Health (Pollution Control), the applicant has agreed to retain the following condition on the Premises Licence which was requested to be removed:

- The Licence holder or his representative shall conduct regular assessments of the noise coming from the premises on every occasion the premises are used for regulated entertainment and shall take steps to reduce the level of noise where it is likely to cause a disturbance to local residents. A written record shall be made of those assessments in a log book kept for that purpose and shall include, the time and date of the checks, the person making them and the results including any remedial action.

3.3 The applicant also agreed to include the following condition following consultation with Environmental Health (Pollution Control).

- There shall be no drinking permitted in the external smoking shelter after 22:30

3.4 A copy of the Premises Licence detailing the conditions of the Premises Licence is available.

4.0 PROMOTION OF LICENSING OBJECTIVES

4.1 Applicants are required to submit as part of their application an operating schedule that sets out how they will conduct/manage their business in accordance with the four Licensing Objectives. A copy of the full application is available.

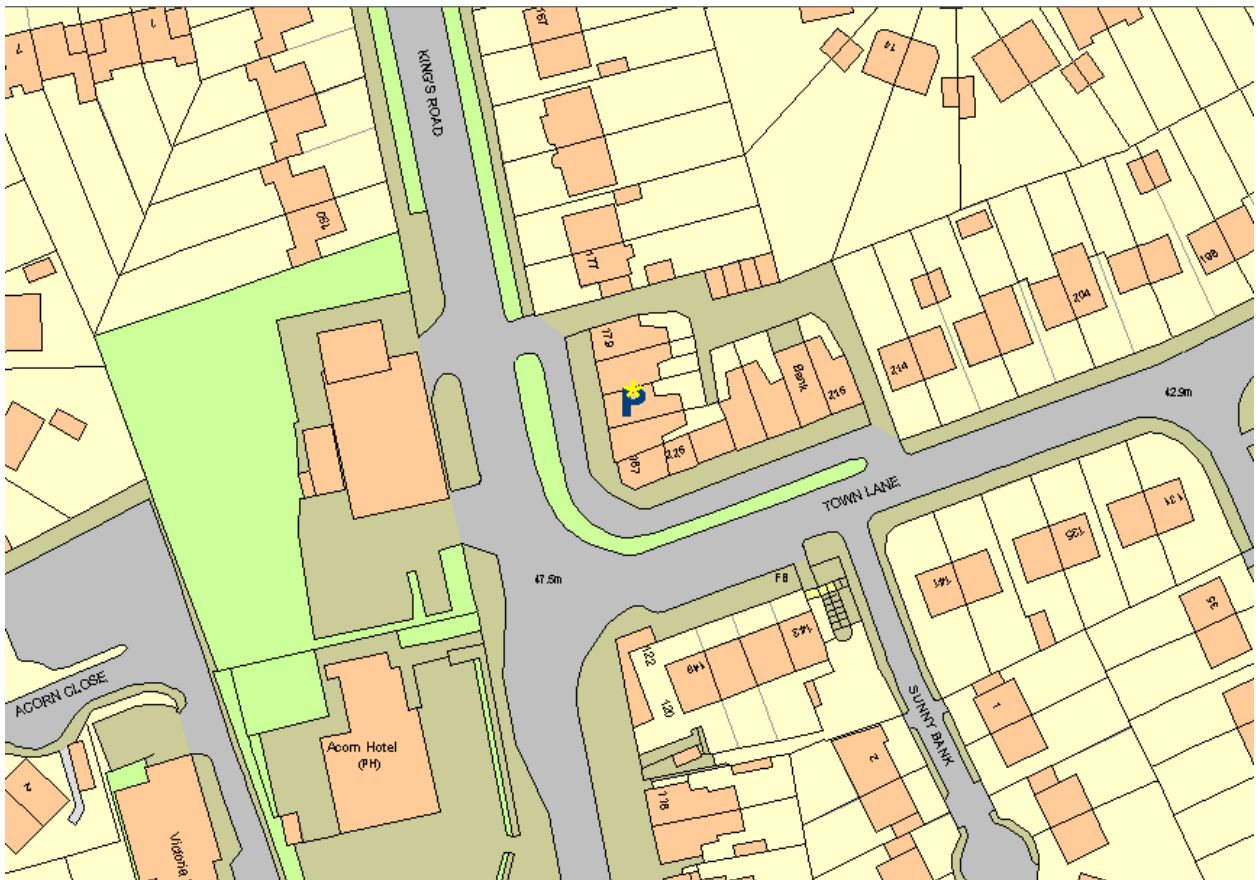
