1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1.1 The purpose of this report is to consider an application to vary a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by **Mr Milosz Kwiecien** and relates to the premises known as the **Convenience Store**, **7 Oxton Road**, **Birkenhead**.





Convenience Store, 7 Oxton Road, Birkenhead – Mr. Milosz Kwiecien.

I am writing, on behalf of my ward colleagues, Councillors Phil Davies and Brian Kenny and myself, to object to the application for the doubling in size of the above shop in Oxton Road, Birkenhead.

My colleague, Councillor Phil Davies, objected to the original application for a licence on the grounds that there were too many similar facilities servicing a very small area and would add to the anti-social behaviour that was already being experienced by local residents.

I am sad to say that Councillor Davies has been proved right. Anti-social behaviour has, indeed, increased in this area which will be evidenced, no doubt, by the Police's objection to this application.

However, I can tell you that I am frequently contacted by local residents and, in particular, a local landlord whose tenants are constantly suffering from the affects of drunken people congregating to socialise and drink together on the street. Their subsequent behaviour is intolerable. Bad language and fighting occurs and we local residents have to suffer the blight of their abandoned empty beer cans and other forms of litter which obviously has to be cleared by the Council.

I would implore the Committee not to agree to this application as it will only increase the sale of alcohol and will undoubtedly impact on the levels of drunkenness and anti-social behaviour which have already contributed to a decline of the area.
