#### 1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to consider an application for a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by **Mr Wshiar Mohamed** and relates to the premises known as **Liscard Convenience Store, 218 Liscard Road, Liscard**.

#### 4.0 PROMOTION OF LICENSING OBJECTIVES

- 4.1 Applicants are required to submit as part of their application an operating schedule that sets out how they will conduct/manage their business in accordance with the four Licensing Objectives. A copy of the full application is available.
- 4.2 Members of the Licensing Act 2003 Sub-Committee are advised that the proposals set out in the operating schedule may become conditions of licence should the licence be granted.

4.3 Following discussions with Merseyside Police (Licensing Division), the applicant has agreed to the following conditions being imposed on the Premises Licence if the application is granted:

- All staff must receive training in relation to under aged sales and records of such training must be maintained and made available to an Authorised Officer on request.
- A challenge 25 Policy must be in place at these premises and posters must be displayed relating to this policy.
- The premises must maintain a refusal log with regular checks. This log must be made available to an Authorised Officer on request.

## **5.0 RELEVANT REPRESENTATIONS**

A representation and a petition has been received and signed by 25 Members of Central Liscard Area Residents Association. A further petition has also been received signed by 87 local residents. A representation has also been received from Ward Councillor, Bernie Mooney. The representation supports the concerns expressed by local residents. A copy of the representation is available.

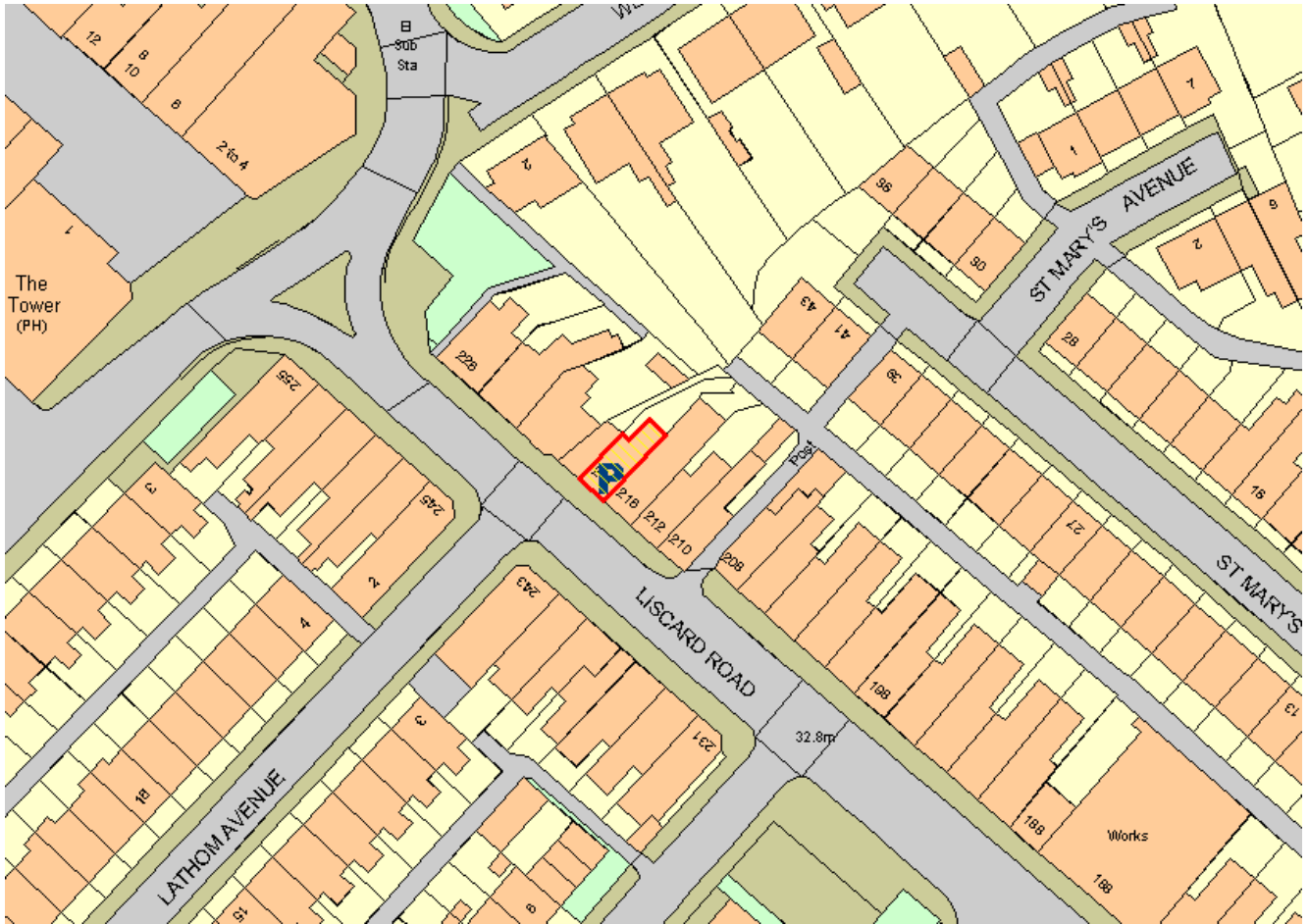
