1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A representation has been received from Merseyside Police. The representation from Merseyside Police relates to a current problem of anti-social behaviour caused by youths within the vicinity of the premises including attempts by these youths to obtain alcohol, either in person or by proxy. Merseyside Police have concerns that if the application is granted then this will provide increased opportunity to commit crime and disorder. Merseyside Police have also advised that the applicant was issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice in June 2013 following the sale of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 whilst working at a store in Prescot, Merseyside. A copy of the representation is available.
