#### **REPORT SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to consider an application for a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by **Joseph Kastanthanaraj** and relates to the premises known as **Premier Off Licence, 55 Old Chester Road, Tranmere**.

3.1 These premises previously had a Premises Licence but this was surrendered on 25 August 2016. The hours permitted under that licence were as follows:

#### Sale by Retail of Alcohol

Sunday to Saturday 08:00 to 23:00

#### Hours Open to the Public

Sunday to Saturday 06:00 to 23:00

The premises now have new operators who submitted a new Premises Licence application and have been operating under Temporary Event Notices pending the outcome of the application.

#### 3.2 **APPLICATION**

The application for a Premises Licence is as follows:

#### Sale by Retail of Alcohol

Sunday to Saturday 08:00 to 23:00

#### Hours Open to the Public

Sunday to Saturday 06:00 to 23:00

#### 3.3 **PROMOTION OF LICENSING OBJECTIVES**

Applicants are required to submit as part of their application an operating schedule that sets out how they will conduct/manage their business to promote the four Licensing Objectives. A copy of the full application is available.

Members of the Licensing Act 2003 Sub-Committee are advised that the proposals set out in the operating schedule may become conditions of licence should the application be granted.

#### 3.4 **RELEVANT REPRESENTATIONS**

The following representations have been received in respect of the above application.

#### **Merseyside Police**

A representation has been received from Merseyside Police who have proposed a number of conditions which they consider are appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives should the application be granted. A copy of the representation is available.

#### **Local Business**

A representation has been received from the proprietor of Go Local Extra, 155 Old Chester Road, Tranmere which is located within the vicinity of Premier Off Licence. The representation has been submitted on behalf of the community who have signed a petition containing 29 persons. The representation relates to concerns of the level of reported anti-social behaviour and crime and disorder within the vicinity of the premises. A copy of the representation is available.
