# REPORT SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to consider an application for a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by **Tranmere Rovers Football Club Limited** and relates to the premises known as **Tranmere Rovers Football Club, Prenton Road West, Birkenhead**.

## 1.0 REASON/S FOR RECOMMENDATION/S

1.1 It is a statutory requirement for this Committee to determine the application due to relevant representations received.

### 3.0 BACKGROUND INFORMATION

3.1 These premises currently have a Premises licence which permits licensable activities within the fabric of the stadium and within a marquee when used as a Fan Zone.

## 3.2 APPLICATION

An application for a Premises Licence has been received to include the areas outside of the fabric of the stadium to allow large events to take place at the football stadium. The application is to permit licensable activities in these areas for no more than 5 days per calendar year. Details of the application are as follows:

# 3.3 PROMOTION OF LICENSING OBJECTIVES

Applicants are required to submit as part of their application an operating schedule that sets out how they will conduct/manage their business to promote the four Licensing Objectives. A copy of the full application is available.

Members of the Licensing Act 2003 Sub-Committee are advised that the proposals set out in the operating schedule may become conditions of licence should the application be granted.

Following discussions with the Responsible Authorities in particular, Merseyside Police and the Licensing Authority the applicant has agreed to include a number of conditions to be placed on the Premises Licence if the application is granted. Details of these proposed conditions will be available at the Hearing for Members information.

## 3.4 RELEVANT REPRESENTATIONS

The following representations have been received in respect of the above application.

#### **Local Residents**

In respect of this application, representations have been received from three Local Residents. The representations relate to concerns that nuisance will be caused by music during the event and nuisance caused by increased parking. The representations also relate to concerns that bats, which are believed to roost within the vicinity of the premises, will be disturbed by the music during the events. Copies of the representations are available.

A response to the representations has been made by the Applicant and is available.
