



The Environmental Health explained that they had concerns due to the close proximity to the local resident's property to the premises in regards to the extended opening hours for the Sunday and Monday nights/ early hours of the morning for the loud music to continue till 06.00 would cause a nuisance.

Mr Zorn responded to questions from Members of the Sub-Committee, Mr A Bayatti, Legal Advisor to the Sub-Committee and the Proprietor.

In determining the matter, Members of the Sub-Committee gave consideration to the objection notice given by the Environmental Health Officer; and the submissions made by Mr Rogers.

### **Resolved**

**(1) That in accordance with Regulation 14(2) of the Licensing Act 2003, the public be excluded from the meeting during consideration of the application.**

**(2) That a Counter Notice be issued under Section 105(2)b of the Licensing Act 2003, resulting in the premises not being licensed between the hours of 4.00 am and 6.00 am on Sunday 27 August 2017 and Monday 28 August 2017.**
