REPORT SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to consider an application to vary a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by **Hideaway Lakes (Wirral) Ltd** and relates to the premises known as **The White Owl, Station Road, Thurstaston**.

The application to vary the Premises Licence as follows:

Sale by Retail of Alcohol

Sunday to Tuesday 11:00 to 21:00
Wednesday to Saturday 11:00 to 22:30

Hours Open to the Public

Sunday to Tuesday 09:00 to 21:00
Wednesday to Saturday 09:00 to 22:30

- 3.3 The applicant has also requested that the following condition be removed from the licence:

- The Sale by Retail of Alcohol and Hours Open to the Public must cease no later than the times specified on the licence, or 30 minutes before sunset.

- 3.4 The Planning Authority have advised that the following restriction is currently imposed on the Planning Permission:

- The café hereby permitted shall be closed between 21:00 hours and 09:00 hours Sundays, Monday and Tuesday and 22:30 hours and 09:00 hours any other day.

3.5 PROMOTION OF LICENSING OBJECTIVES

Applicants are required to submit as part of their application an operating schedule that sets out how they will conduct/manage their business to promote the four Licensing Objectives. A copy of the full application is available.

Members of the Licensing Act 2003 Sub-Committee are advised that the proposals set out in the operating schedule may become conditions of licence should the application be granted.
