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PROVISION FOR CHILDREN WITH PROFOUND AND MULTIPLE LEARNING DIFFICULTIES

We ask that the Council develops, as a matter of urgency, a consistent and coherent policy for children with profound and multiple learning difficulties. This will include the provision at school and outside the school and deal with issues throughout their lives. This policy should demonstrate very close involvement with the parents and families of the children.

We ask that the following issues be included:

- the need for children to be in a safe environment
- the need for children to have a rich, multisensory and stimulating environment
- the need for the children to be understood by their families and those adults working with them through a totally communicating environment
- the rights of children to interact with multiagency staff who are experienced in dealing with their needs
- the need for wrap around support for the families of all these children
- the right to consistent respite arrangements, taking into account the particular needs of the children.
