

## WIRRAL CHILDREN'S TRUST BOARD – 15<sup>th</sup> July 2011

### Proposed Restructure of Children and Young People's Department

---

#### 1.0 Background

With regard to the proposed structure of the department, from 1<sup>st</sup> July we will move from four branches to three, upon the retirement of the Head of Participation and Inclusion, Peter Edmondson. The functions of the Participation and Inclusion branch will be shared to the most appropriate of the remaining three branches, Children's Social Care, Learning and Achievement and Planning and Resources. Attached are two sheets showing the changes, the first shows the moves of the various elements/functions of the Participation and Inclusion Branch (the functions shown in red) and the second sheet shows the three branch structure from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2011. With the exception of Youth, Youth Offending Service and Anti-Social Behaviour moving to the Children's Social Care branch, this branch remains unchanged, with the majority of other functions transferring to the Learning and Achievement branch and some - Transport, Admissions and Commissioning to the Planning and Resources Branch.

**The proposed restructure is still subject to formal agreement.**
