

Children and Young People's Plan 2012 onwards

1. Background

The Children and Young People's Plan for 2011/12 will cease in April 2012. The Plan has been well received by partners and feedback from children and young people has been very positive. The current plan is delivered and monitored by the five Outcome Strategy Groups, (OSG). Feedback to the Children's Trust Executive, (CTE), from the groups are that they work well and the plan provides a clear framework to focus partners on delivering improved outcomes for the children and young people of the Borough.

2. Planning for 2012 onwards

The planning process for Children and Young People's Plan from April 2012 was discussed at the Children's Trust Executive meeting on the 13th September. The following recommendations were made.

- The plan for 2011/12 will be reviewed inline with previous plans.
- A one year plan should be created for 2012/13.
- The format and layout of the plan should be maintained to enable continuity and branding.
- A consultation with children and young people should be undertaken during October, using the Youth Voice Conference and the Teen Wirral website.
- The priorities from 2011/12 will be rolled forward with refreshed actions for delivery.

3. RECOMMENDATIONS

That Wirral Children's Trust Board endorsed the report and agree to the production of a one year Children and Young People's Plan for 2012/13.
