

1.0 Background

- 1.1 The Children and Young People's Plan (CYPP) is a overarching strategic plan developed by Wirral Children's Trust for all organisations providing services for the children and young people of Wirral. It is developed and reviewed by multi-agency groups ensuring all partner organisations and children and young people are fully involved. The CYPP is reviewed annually.
- 1.2 In September 2012 Wirral Children's Trust Board approved the production of a new three CYPP for 2013-16. In order to ensure that this plan is fit for purpose particularly in the current environment of austerity and change a rigorous new priority setting approach was developed through the Children's Trust Executive.
- 1.3 The proposed new priorities have been collated and were presented to the Board for approval in March 2013. The new plan has now been completed and is provided to the Board for endorsement. Along side this plan is the Equality Impact Assessment for the new plan has been produced and is also present for consideration and endorsement. A children and young people's version of the plan, feedback response to the consultation are under development.

- 2) That the Board approve the Children and Young People's Plan 2013-16 new priorities developed through the stakeholder priority setting approach.
