<b>Summary of Paper</b>	<p>The System Leadership programme is a ground-breaking collaboration between Public Health England, National Skills Academy for Social Care, NHS Leadership Academy, Virtual Staff College, Local Government Association and the Leadership Centre, that enables areas to create system wide change through leadership collaboration and development. Together these partners have pooled resources to assemble a fund of over £1m to support up to 30 places in this breakthrough project (see Appendix A).</p> <p>Wirral submitted an application, at the end of May, to support the development of a local Food Plan (see Appendix B). This application was successful (see Appendix C). As a result Wirral will receive a package of support, including the time of an experienced leadership development enabler (equivalent to one day per week) to support the development of the Food Plan whilst advancing leadership in Wirral to the benefit of residents. As part of this programme Wirral will also have access to further varied support including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• learning networks hosted by the King's Fund</li> <li>• participation in Future Vision – a national leadership development programme</li> <li>• access to the knowledge-hub where information from the across the places will be shared</li> <li>• a number of free consultancy days from a limited range of private sector partners</li> <li>• participation in the Commissioning Academy.</li> </ul>
