### 1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1.1 The purpose of this report is to consider an application for a Premises Licence under the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003. The application is made by **Chambers (Wirral) Limited** and relates to the premises known as **Chambers Bar and Grill, 25 Argyle Street, Birkenhead**.

2.1 These premises previously had a Premises Licence trading under the name of Sonny's on the Square.

2.2 On 9 July 2013 this Premises Licence lapsed due to the Premises Licence Holder, Sonny on the Square Limited, becoming dissolved.

#### Regulated Entertainment

Sunday to Thursday 10:00 to 01:00  
Friday and Saturday 10:00 to 04:00

#### Late Night Refreshment

Sunday to Thursday 23:00 to 01:00  
Friday and Saturday 23:00 to 04:00

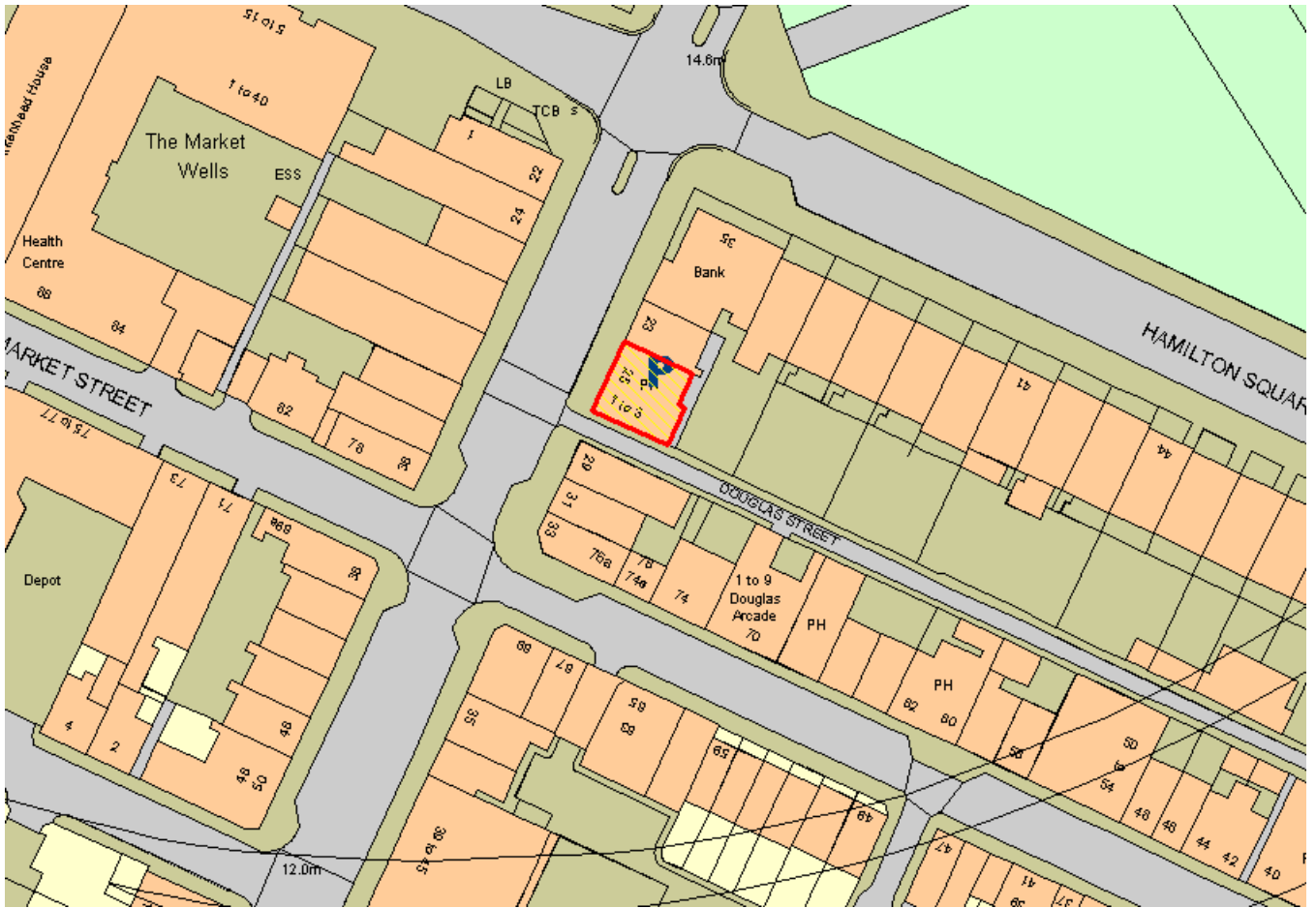
