| <b>Summary of Paper</b> | <p><b>Background</b></p> <p>The Winterbourne View stocktake was designed in order to to enable local areas to assess their progress against commitments set out in the Winterbourne View Concordat, to share good practice and to identify local development needs.</p> <p>The report, published jointly by the Local Government Association and NHS England, is an analysis that covers all 152 health and wellbeing board areas.</p> <p>Wirral contributed to the stocktake and has received feedback based on our submission.
