SUBJECT: LOVE WIRRAL GRANT FUNDING

1. RECOMMENDATION:

1.1. The Leader is recommended to approve the payments of funding for 80 projects that were successful in applying for funding from the Love Wirral grant process. £36,318.18 will be awarded in total. The overall process and budget for the Love Wirral grants was authorised by the Council Leader in a delegated decision report on 7th October. This report requests authorisation for officers to arrange payment to successful project applicants.

2. REASONS FOR THE DECISION

2.1. 80 projects will be awarded 'Love Wirral Grant' funding, the projects are spread across Wirral. The 'Love Wirral Grant' will be used by projects to improve and look after their neighbourhoods. This project will enable communities to play an active role in presenting Wirral to the world during the Open 2014 and beyond. The grants encourage the public to take pride in where they live.

3. STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

The recommendations are made further to legal advice from the Deputy Monitoring Officer and the Section 151 Officer has confirmed that they do not incur unlawful expenditure. They are also compliant with equality legislation and an equality analysis and impact assessment has been completed. 
