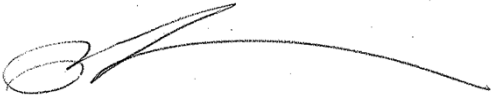
- To ensure equity across the service and in the application of the Fairer Charging Policy.
