Medical checks are undertaken on initial application and <b>then annually from age 65, as currently.</b>	64
Medical checks are undertaken on initial application and <b>thereafter annually.</b>	19
Medical checks are undertaken on initial application and <b>thereafter every three years with checks being undertaken annually from age 65.</b>	49
Medical checks are undertaken on initial application and thereafter every <b>five years with checks being undertaken annually from age 65.</b>	18
Medical checks are undertaken on initial application and thereafter for <b>each renewal, with checks being undertaken annually from age 65.</b>	4
Medical checks are undertaken on initial application and thereafter every <b>five years from the age of 45 years until the age of 65 years, with checks being undertaken annually from age 65.</b> This would be in line with Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA) requirements for LGV and PCV drivers.	43
