Dear Deputy Mayor McLachlan,

In light of the recent OFSTED report, we the undersigned, are requesting an Extraordinary Council meeting at the next available opportunity.

We have been reassured to hear the Chief Executive has already taken rapid action to begin to understand the challenges and put in place an improvement board and action plan. We also welcome the decision of the Leader of The Council to immediately commit a further £2million to enact any changes or improvements the board recommends.

The safety of the vulnerable in our community, especially youngsters under the protection of the Council and its partners, has always been a priority for this authority. When the 2020 pledges to protect the vulnerable were universally approved by Council and The Wirral Partnership, it was a positive sign of how all members, officers and wider public sector groups were committed to improving outcomes for residents, irrespective of politics or organisation bias.
