Report of Local Government Ombudsman

The Local Government Ombudsman has issued a report following her investigation of four complaints against Wirral Council. The complaints were about an Education & Children's Services matter. The Ombudsman found that there had been fault on the part of the Council, and this had caused injustice to the complainants.

Wirral Council has agreed to take action which the Ombudsman regards as providing a satisfactory remedy for the complaint.

The Council must now consider the report and tell the Ombudsman within three months (or such longer period as she may agree) what it proposes to do.

Copies of the report will be available for public inspection during normal office hours at Wallasey Town Hall, Brighton Street, Wallasey, CH44 8ED, for three weeks starting on 23rd February 2017. Anyone is entitled to take copies of the report or extracts from it. Copies will be supplied at a reasonable charge.
