REPORT SUMMARY

Recorded Music and Anything of a Similar Description

Sunday to Thursday 08:00 to 00:30
Friday and Saturday 08:00 to 01:30

Late Night Refreshment

Sunday to Thursday 23:00 to 00:30
Friday and Saturday 23:00 to 01:30

Hours Open to the Public

Sunday to Thursday 08:00 to 00:30
Friday and Saturday 08:00 to 01:30

3.2 The Licensing Act 2003 Sub-Committee may, having regard to the application for a Review and any relevant representations, take such of the following steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- Modify the Conditions of the Licence.

- Exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the Licence.
- Remove the Designated Premises Supervisor.
- Suspend the Licence for a period not exceeding three months.
- Revoke the Licence.

The licensing authority may decide that no action is appropriate if it finds that the Review does not require it to take any steps that are appropriate to promote the licensing objectives.

3.3 APPLICATION

3.4 An application has been received from Merseyside Police to review the Premises Licence for the premises known as the Rock Station Hotel. The grounds for review are in relation to a number of crime related incidents that have occurred at the premises.
