## 2.0 REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- 2.1 The grant has been provided to the council for projects that will make an immediate impact in towns. The proposals for utilising the grant have taken in to account the Towns Fund Intervention Framework, key themes and proposals that are emerging from meetings of the Town Deal Board, as well as the council's emerging Birkenhead Regeneration Framework. Delivery of the grant will bring about an immediate benefit to businesses and residents in the area to which the grant is applied.
- 1.2 The grant forms part of government's accelerated capital programme for economic recovery with a requirement for disbursement of funds no later than 31st March 2021.
