1	Could the PSPO area be extended to cover the shops and flats here? Police are trying to keep a presence, but I believe the area would benefit from extra surveillance. Thank you.		
2	It is about time something is being done about the behaviour of certain people on the Woodchurch. One thing that concerns me over the small area that's being monitored is that the people involved will just find another area of the estate to terrorise. There are plenty of open spaces, my main concern is for the small park area off New Hey Road and Carrbridge road, The Junction Park. We already have young people wrecking the area where families make use of the facilities on a regular basis. One of the swings has had to be replaced a number of times due to vandalism. There has been racist and homophobic graffiti written on the slide. There is evidence of teenagers using nitrogen bulbs. There are youths loitering, waiting on drug deals. There are grafters, using various types of bikes to deliver drugs. We have had young girls setting the field alight. I feel that the order will need to be extended to other open areas of the estate once you have made an impact on the initial area that has been proposed.		
3	The proposed area does not cover the area where groups of youths gather to smoke drugs and basically hang around causing nuisance and intimidation I suggest extending the area up to Meadow Crescent, this would then include the grassed area at the side of The Meadow and the alley between the flats and the rear of the properties which is used as a rat run by the afore mentioned youths		

4	We visited the temple in Eltham Green, i have been shouted at racially and kids hanging around till 11pm and have thrown stone at one of my friend (assault has been registered with police. These incidents have been happening almost everday, everyone has been scared to visit this hindu temple. Could you please consider adding this area in the pspo.	
5	The proposed area does not cover the area where groups of youths gather to smoke drugs and basically hang around causing nuisance and intimidation I suggest extending the area up to Meadow Crescent, this would then include the grassed area at the side of The Meadow and the alley between the flats and the rear of the properties which is used as a rat run by the afore mentioned youths	
6	I write in full support of this proposal. I live just out of the proposed area and have teenage children. On the whole it is ok however none will go to the local shops on Hoole Road for the reasons this is being proposed. I do go and often feel intimidated. I work fulltime and want to feel protected in my neighbourhood as well as feeling my teenagers feel safe enough to nip to the local shops in my absence. I cannot imagine how elderly members of the community feel who don't drive and must attend these shops if my teenagers feel intimidated.	
7	I'm 100% percent behind this plan but I see a couple of major flaws! It's the lack of coverage for the routes from The Meadow up to Arrowe Park (Meadow Crescent leading to Church Lane were Commonfield Rd Surgery has been subject to numerous acts of	

vandalism & random shops on Fleetcroft Rd & houses along the way, Then there's Meadow Crescent on the other side at the top of The Meadow along with Greenwood Rd the top end as well as the bottom end they're largely used routes by motorcycles & gangs heading to Arrowe Parks playing field which gets littered & ruined by bike tracks, that's the Meadow Crescent then Pool Lane route, empty cans, cider bottles & stolen bike parts & theft & vandalism pave the way, I also believe Houghton Rd from Hoole Rd up should be on the plans as it's at the top of Hoole Rd,	
Pemberton Rd, Greenwood Rd & Meadow Crescent). All the proposed area's are very very valid spots but it'd be pointless & make life so much harder than what it already is for the people, companies, & a G.P surgery if the places that aren't in brackets weren't considered & ultimately covered! Plus if you want to get rid of pests or an inconvenience you do it 100%! I believe that a larger presence on The Meadow would deter said routes but then you'd have to take Home Farm Rd leading to Meadow Crescent then Church Lane into account!? (for safety purposes I'd kindly wish to remain anonymous!).

9 The proposed PSPO needs to be extended to include the Grasswood Road into Cornwood Drive area, there is constant police presence in the close and ongoing ASB that One Vision Housing the landlord is NOT dealing with.	
There are constant groups of lads between 12 and late 20s, mostly wearing black, or at least dark clothes with hoods up and tops pulled up over mouth. They hang out	

bottom of the meadow, opposite the shops but up the side of the flats making lots of noise, staring as you walk past and you feel intimidated. The same groups have climbed upon the roof of the flats and walked along them a number of times when we are in the back garden and I feel like I can't even stay in the garden, as they stir.

They climb up and sit on the garages behind our houses, the neighbours have told them to get down a few times but they argue saying they aren't doing anything,

but they are over looking our gardens.

They fight on there, argue, and I have seen plenty run up and over them when sirens are heard.

The gun shot went off near our house.

The number of times the bikes, pedal or motorised ones, along with scooters and motor bikes shoot across from one side of the meadow to the other without looking as they cross Pemberton. They have nearly taken out adults dogs and children, and nearly been hit by cars themselves.

They take or do drugs and sit on the meadow in gangs swearing, making loud noises and trying to get a rise out of anyone that walks past. Constant visitor's hanging round "exchanging goods"

Windows being smashed in at midnight, arguing and shouting between the same people weeks in and weeks out.

Even buses get things thrown at them when I've been on them, luckily nothings broken, and even if it did, I don't think the bus drivers would feel confident enough around there to do anything, or nor should they have to.

Litter, same fences broken after they've been fixed, numerus times.

	I shouldn't have to worry about leaving the house, sitting in my house, or garden or worrying about my 17 year old going out to college.	
11	Yes it's in regards to the public spaces protection order on the Woodchurch. There are so many wonderful people on the woodchurch and their lives are being made harder due to a few idiots that think they can do what they like. Life is hard at the moment for many anyway. Fearing just popping the shops shouldn't be one of them	
12		You have one of these in new ferry and it is well known that police are not there most of the time on Woodchurch windows getting smashed in the middle of the night will there be a police presence in the night these kids in balaclavas will just move to arrowe park shops always happened
13	Hi yes we are in full support of the pspo couldn't happen soon enough in my opinion as the nuisance person/person's hang around my house often throwing stones and things at cars (cost husband £85 to get window repaired not so long ago) what I would like to know ishow will it be policed? And how often will police be around?	
14	I would like to thank you for pspo letter I'm sorry I didn't get out to speak to you Things are very bad here. Last week I tackled 15 or so youths smashing up tv sets etc. Then kicking my fence. I was then threatened And then a person dressed in black on a motor bike started riding up and down. Just his eyes showing.	

Thank you for your recent letter concerning the proposed public spaces protection order (PSPO) for the area of Hoole road Woodchurch and the Meadow.

I am in total favour of this order being put in place ASAP.

I have lived on Hoole Road now for over 20 years and brought my children up and now help care for my Grandchildren whilst their parents are working. There has been an increase of kids and young adults hanging around the shop, racing around on their bikes kicking balls at cars and people passing, It has become an increasingly less friendly place to be. They show no respect for the shop keepers or other people's property. I have challenged many a child in my years if seen to be behaving badly, often with a successful result for all concerned. But sadly, attitudes have changed and the kids wearing masks just shout profanities to anyone who challenges them. I hope this order will bring about a good changed for our community.

My son is 11 years old so this means he can't ride his bike from school to the shop I don't think this is right also we live in the selected area and he plays out with his friends when he hasn't got activities on and at times there is not much for the kids to do, at times he will be stood round just chatting to his friends so does this mean he will be moved on from by his own home he's a good boy and will never be part of any trouble I can guarantee that. I get that some kids are up

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	to no good but surely you can approach this differently we don't have any bother in our road.	
17	There are already laws in place to deal with the Yobs, riding Bikes on the pavements etc. and these laws are not enforced, as there are never any Police around, and even if there were, I doubt if anything would be done. I feel completely unprotected and would not venture out after dusk, even if I was broken into, the Police would just issue me with a crime number, therefore, introducing further regulations would be just a waste of time.
