1.0 DECISION:

The Assistant Director of Neighbourhoods, Safety & Transport has decided to approve the award of a contract with a term of 3 years, for Maintenance, Supply & Installation Of CCTV Cameras & Associated Equipment, for Wirral Council assets to Synectics Security (Synectics Security Limited – Registration Number 05831231) through the Eastern Shires Procurement Organisation (ESPO) framework. The contract value is up to £850,000.

2.0 REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Council operates public surveillance camera equipment for the purposes of crime reduction, public safety and community reassurance. CCTV is a proven key contributor to delivering safe and pleasant communities. Regular maintenance of the CCTV network is required to be compliant with the regulatory framework around public space surveillance.

The Senior Category Manager Procurement advised that the chosen route to market will be via a direct award to the contractor – Synectics Security, utilising ESPO Framework - Security And Surveillance Equipment & Services 628_19.

ESPO is a public sector owned professional buying organisation (PBO), specialising in providing a wide range of goods and services to the public sector.

This will support future digital improvements for the Council.

3.0 STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

This is a UK Procurement Law Compliant framework. This ESPO framework provides a compliant route to market for the procurement of Security And Surveillance Equipment & Services for all public sector bodies.
