Appendix 2: Common education terms

| Attainment 8 | Attainment 8 is a whole school performance <br> measure that is calculated based on the grades <br> achieved by students across 8 key subjects. The <br> maximum score is 9, English and Maths have a <br> double weighting. |
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| Progress 8 | Progress 8 is a measure that indicates how <br> much a secondary school has helped pupils <br> progress over a five-year period. This measure <br> takes a pupil's performance in relation to their <br> peers at primary school level, compares it with <br> their performance at KS4 (their Attainment 8 <br> score) establishes whether the individual has <br> progressed. They are then grouped together to <br> get an average for a school's overall score. |
| 9-4 - English and Maths | The percentage of pupils that have achieved a <br> grade 4 or above in both English and Maths |
| 9-5 - English and Maths | The percentage of pupils that have achieved a <br> grade 5 or above in both English and Maths |
| FSM | Free School Meal is a statutory benefit available <br> to school- aged children from families who <br> receive other qualifying benefits |
| PP | Pupil premium is funding available to schools <br> for pupils who have been receipt of free school <br> meals in the last 6 years. |
| CLA | Special Educational Needs and Disability |
| SEND | Education and health care plan, a plan outlining <br> the education, health and social care needs of a <br> child with additional needs |
| EHCP | Identified with SEND needs but not in receipt of <br> an EHCP |
