1.1	Background		
1.1.1	NHS Cheshire and Merseyside is working with each of the nine Places in the Cheshire and Merseyside Integrated Care System (ICS) to establish robust governance and assurance mechanisms through strong partnership arrangements.		
	The Wirral Place Based Partnership Board (WPBPB) is the forum where NHS Cheshire and Merseyside conducts business pertaining to the Borough transparently in the public domain and in collaboration with system partners. These arrangements also support further delegation of decision making and resources to each borough.		
	The Place Governance Manual V1. Was presented to the PBPB in July 2024 and approved on the basis that it would remain a dynamic document and provided a useful overview of the operation of all governance arrangements at Place to ensure clarity, and consistency in approach and to establish appropriate information and assurance flows.		
	The PBPB recognised that a further review of the Governance Manual would be completed to consider the Terms of Reference of the supporting groups. This has now been completed and all updated ToRs are included in the Place Governance Manual V2.
