- Seek regular feedback from people, that is constructive and honest about their experience
- Demonstrating the value our work is having
- Welcoming people to be meaningfully involved
- Making decisions about shaping services together
- Embedding coproduction into everything we do
- Supporting people for their input


## We commit to delivering coproduction using the following principles:

Trust - We will decide priorities together to find the best solutions.
Shared Understanding - We will agree on what we want to achieve, what good looks like and be mindful of everyone's commitments.

Equal Partnership - Everyone can take part, whatever their needs or abilities.
We can all learn from each other.
Creative Thinking - We will plan creatively and do things differently, working in ways which are best for people.

Communication - We will keep everyone updated and informed, being clear about what we can and can't do and make sure our communications are accessible for everyone.
