**REQUEST TO REQUISITION AN EXTRAORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING**

Please find below signatures from six Members of the Conservative Group requisitioning an extraordinary meeting of the Council to discuss the Council's response to the consultation on the revised National Planning Policy Framework.

The signatories to this requisition note:

Following Council on Monday, the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government announced on Tuesday a revision to the formula for new housing.

That revised formula would mandate Wirral to release land for development that would enable 1,755 dwellings a year to be built; 35,100 over the course of a 20-year Local Plan and 14,000 MORE than our current draft Local Plan, as agreed by Council.

As the facts have materially, and radically, changed, potentially affecting swathes of Wirral's Green Belt, we write to request an Extraordinary Council be called to agree our response to the Ministry's consultation on this change in formula, along with other changes to the National Planning Policy Framework.

The Ministry has a closing date for their consultation of 24 September 2024 and we are keen that Wirral Council does everything possible to reject this new, centrally-driven, mandatory target.
