

Protect Our Environment

Quarter 3: October - December 2024. The narrative is related to measures that have changed in this quarter compared to the last available data

In Quarter 3 new data is available for 4 measures for this theme, information about their performance is included below.

Areas Of Improvement

The percentage of A roads where maintenance should be considered has remained the same in 2023/24 compared to the previous three years, this is on a par with the England benchmark. The percentage of B and C roads where maintenance should be considered has improved to 7% in 2023/24 compared to the previous year (8%), this is on a par with England and North West benchmarks. The City Region Sustainable Transport Settlement allocation has enabled us to maintain the A classified roads at a steady state, the additional funding provided by the Department for Transport from the redistribution of funds from the High Speed 2 project, has allowed us to reduce the deterioration on the classified B and C roads.

Areas Requiring Improvement

The number of both cycling and walking journeys recorded on key routes in Wirral in quarter 3 have decreased compared to the same period last year. Longer term monitoring across an increased number of years (the current data only compares 2 years) would provide a better understanding of overall trends as year-to-year quarterly usage can be influenced by many other factors such as weather conditions or economic conditions (access to cycles). The Council has recently approved a Core Active Travel Network which over time will support the development of high-quality walking and cycling routes across the Borough to support increased usage of these modes and are working closely with the Liverpool City Region and Merseyside Police to enable and encourage increased levels of safer active travel.



Key Activities Related To This Theme

In quarter 3 Council Rangers based at Wirral Country Park have been recognised as the 'Best of the Best' by the people behind the prestigious Green Flag awards. They were named 'Team of the Year' in the annual Best of the Best Awards organised by the national environmental charity, Keep Britain Tidy. The awards celebrate the volunteers, park staff and groups behind the success of parks that managed to scoop a sought-after Green Flag Award earlier in the year. More than 80 Wirral schools participate in the Eco Schools programme, which is run by the environmental charity, Keep Britain Tidy. The commitment to the cause is further demonstrated by the fact 66 of those schools have been awarded with a prestigious Eco-Schools Green Flag award this year – a rise of 13 on the previous year. Being an Eco School means that the students and teachers learn about the environmental challenges we face and how they can make a positive impact.


